Project: Learn tips on cutting fabric for your projects. Using fusible web or not, cutting fabric will be precise and can streamline your cutting process for many projects. The project is a pillow with the word “Love” applique.

***Basic Supplies**

Bring your Scan N Cut (or other cutting machine) if you'd like, I will have one in the classroom to use.

Standard cutting mat

Cutting blade

Supply List:

Bring 4-6 fabric swatches approx 10” square for sample cutting.

To make the pillow sample:

Fabric in 2 coordinating prints

2 pieces for center, 10”x10”

4 pieces for sides, 4”x10”

Solid color that will contrast well with center piece, at least 11”x9”

fusible web, at least 11”x9” (heat and bond featherweight)

12” invisible or regular Zipper in coordinating color, if desired

Pillow form (This can be made in class or afterwards)

2 pieces of light colored fabric, 10”x16”

polyfil to stuff

You must give a 3-day notice to transfer the fee to another class. Student must have basic knowledge of their own sewing machine, including how to operate and thread your own machine.
