Please Note- We are doing project #6 the wall hanging the hoop. These directions are in a different file folder than the block directions.

Supply List:

Embroidery Machine with your largest hoop-page 3 of directions to see what size block you can make

Pickle Pie Embroidery Design Pack-

Cost is \$5.00 if you sign up for the class

USB stick- Load Snowman and Baby Its Cold Outside block designs on stick before class

No Show Mesh Cut away Stabilizer-2 Pieces to fit hoop

Fusible Seam Tape- 2 pieces about 10 inches each (1/4 inch or 1/2 inch)

Fusible Webbing- (Shape Flex 101) at least **4** pieces the Same size as your background pieces.

Batting-low loft- 2 pieces the size of you background fabrics

Fabric Requirements- See pages 9-12 and pages 25 &27 for more information-Below are the basic fabrics needed

Snowman Block – Background and Backing Fabric- 1/2 yard, White Fabric-1 Fat quarter, Red Fabric-for tie – 3 x 4 inches (Page 9 of directions)

Baby Its Cold Outside Block- Border and Backing Fabric- 1/2 yard, Center Fabric-1 Fat Quarter

Ribbon- to connect Blocks & Hanger, 2 1/2 yards of Grosgrain 7/8 inch - your color choice.

Before Class: Gather supplies, read over directions, load design on USB stick and do any prep work like pressing Shape flex 101 onto the background fabric.

Embroidery Supplies

- Machine/Embroidery Foot & Power Cord
- Hoop- largest one you have
- User Manual for your machine
- Fabric /Applique Scissors
- Thread to match your project
- Pre-Wound bobbins
- Microtex Needles size 80/12
