16 inch polyester Zipper
16" x 1 inch insertion Lace trim
60" of 5/32" cotton Piping
2 colors of wooly nylon to contract ruffled fabric
Wonder Tape
14 inch pillow form

# Serger Supplies

- □ Serger/Foot Petal & Power Cord
  □ Presser Feet:Lace Applicator Foot,Cording
  Foot, Clear Foot optional
  □ Serger Thread 4 cones
  □ Fabric Scissors and Paper Scissors
  - ☐ Seam Ripper☐ Wonder Clips
- ☐ Fabric Marker/chalk ☐ Rotary Cutter and Cutting Mat (optional)

### FABRIC: See Sample in Store.

Four – 2 ½ X WOF strips for ruffles in one color

Four - 2 1/2 X WOF strips for ruffles in another color

One- 2 ½ X WOF strip for side center pieces: then cut into two 2 ½ x 22" strips

Two- 5 ½ X 22" fabric strips for center backing piece.

One- 5 ¼ X 22" white fabric for center backing piece.

Two- 5 ½ X 22 fabric piece for ruffle base.

One- 5 X 14 piece of fabric and One-10 x 14 backing piece of fabric. These should be the same fabric.

2" X 60" continuous bias for cording

#### **Before Class:**

Have your fabric cut and labeled using above measurement.

Practice threading your serger for the following:

- 4 thread Overlock
- 3 thread Narrow Rolled Hem
- 3 thread Narrow Overlock
- 2 thread Flatlock Wide

Narrow Cover stitch Right (if you have a BabyLock Ovation or Evolution)

We will assemble as much of the pillow as possible in class.

Class will start and end promptly—please be set up and ready to begin class on time.

Your payment is your commitment to your class and to the instructor. Refund will be issued IF a minimum enrollment of (2) is not met. You must give a 3-day notice to transfer the fee to another class. Student must have basic knowledge of their own sewing machine, including how to operate and thread your own machine. **Please note:** Neither your instructor or Pins & Needles can be responsible for forgotten supplies and/or equipment. Please be sure to have all of your supplies properly labeled.
