Supply List:

Embroidery Machine with a 6 x 10 hoop
USB stick, I will load your design for you.

Towel or Fabric:

Large Bath towel or Beach towel.

Coordinating or matching hand towel with a
1 ½ - 2 woven band.

2 strips of a coordinating fabric- 4 x width of the hand towel plus 1 inch.

2 yards of webbing (for the handles)

Thread:

2 colors of your choice for the Monogram

Bobbin: Pre-wound neutral color or white

Stabilizer:

2 pieced to fit hoop – Wet n Gone (fibrous wash away, not wet n gone tacky)

2 pieces of Water Soluble Stabilizer , this will go on top of towel

New Embroidery Needle if you have not changed yours out recently


Before Class:

Come in at 5pm to get started early if you want!

Gather supplies and bring to class

If you need to borrow a machine, please state that when signing up for class. Be sure to bring your hoop from home to use!

Class will start and end promptly—please be set up and ready to begin class on time.

 Your payment is your commitment to your class and to the instructor. Refund will be issued IF a minimum enrollment of (2) is not met. You must give a 3-day notice to transfer the fee to another class.
