Pre-class Homework:

Cut (3) 14" squares from your top fabric and (3) 14" squares from your backing fabric

Cut (3) 14" squares from your batting or flannel

Layer your backing fabric (wrong side up), then batting, and your top fabric (right side up). Safety pin together and quilt as desired. You just need to do enough to keep the three layers together so that you can apply the binding. I suggest either straight line grid quilting or free motion stippling.

You now have three 14" x 14" rectangles - we will trim these down in class

Cut (5) 2.5" X WOF strips for the binding

SEWING NOTIONS AND EQUIPMENT

Sewing machine, power cord and foot control. Please be sure you know how to operator your machine.

¼" quilting foot if your machine has dual feed or a walking foot if your machine does not

100% cotton 50 wt. thread

Bobbin wound with the thread you have chosen

New 80/12 sewing needle

Straight pins

Rotary cutting matt, 45mm rotary cutter with a sharp blade

Rotary cutting ruler (omnigrd)

Seam ripper, small scissors for thread, erasable pen or fabric chalk

FABRIC

½ yd. for the tops

½ yd. for the backing

½ yd. for the binding

½ yd. thin cotton batting or flannel

Feel free to bring paper and pencil for notes and your own snack! We will have sew much fun!
