



### Blooming Pomegranates

In this workshop we will be perfecting our needle turn applique. Perfect for any skill level. Needle turn applique is not hard and is very portable. This block is 15" x 21" making it a great size for framing or adding ruffle for a pillow. This is a block from a BOM pattern. The pattern for the block will be provided in the workshop.

If you would like to purchase the pattern for the entire quilt you may do so at wholesale cost of \$14.

### Fabric Requirements

**Kent Chambray Navy #2942- 16" x 22"**

**Fine Floral Red #10589- 5" x 8 ½"**

**Dots and Blooms Red #10599- 5" x 7"**

**Paisley Pink #10592- 4" x 5"**

**Nikko Red #3831- 2" x 3"**

**Nikko Green Plaid #3822-3" x 6 ½"**

**Nikko Light Green #3828- 2 ¼" x 4"**

**Nikko Green/Brown- 16 ½" x 16 ½" square (includes fabric for future blocks)**

**Paisley Green #10591- 3" x 6 ½"**

**Fine Floral Green #10588-4 ½" x 8 ½"**

**Main Floral Beige #10586 - 8 ½" square**

**Cream Plaid #PRF-820 - 8 ½" x 10"**

The fabrics listed are what I used in the sample. You should use whatever you like or have on hand. These dimensions are just a guide.

### **Workshop supplies**

Freezer paper, sharpie, sharp scissors and paper scissors, iron, chalk pencil, fray check or fray block, applique pins, Aurifil 80 wt thread to match your fabrics or YLI 100 wt silk in a neutral color such as 235, milliners needle size 11, ½" bias tape maker
