





### *Snowflakes Softly Falling*

In response to a posting on the TAS Guestbook page. Our President, Jaydee Price has designed these charming snowflake patterns.

Start with an 8" square piece of paper and fold it following the diagram above. If you want to make larger or smaller flakes, just use a larger piece of paper. The key here is to make sure the paper is square.

Jaydee says the 1/4" seam allowance has already been added to the patterns. The needle turn method would use a 1/8" seam allowance typical of Hawaiian appliqué. Of course you could also fuse them and machine appliqué around the edges.
