2-201 Stacked Squares Block Calling all embroidery people. This is the technique for you to showcase your embroidered blocks without having to use paper foundation piecing. However, Stacked squares is for everybody. You can create depth in your quilt tops as well as secondary patterns.

Prerequisite Preferred: 1-1001 Large Square Squared[®] of TU Freshman Year

Required Tools: Large Square Squared[®] tool

Required Technique Sheet: Stacked Squares

Required Design Sheet: Stacked Squares

*These items can be purchased at your local quilt shop

Basic Sewing Supplies

- Sewing Machine with power cords and manual (just in case)
- Thread
- Machine needles
- Snips or trimming scissors
- Seam ripper

Basic Quilting Supplies

- Rotary cutter with a sharp blade
- Marking Pencil (mechanical will do)
- Small cutting mat
- Straight edge ruler approx. 6" x 12" or so
- Invisigrip (Optional)
- Best Press or light starch (Optional)

Fabric Requirements: It will be important for you to have your fabric cut prior to class because we will need as much time in class for instruction as possible.

Block with 3 rounds or zippie bag 1

Layer	Fabric	Cut
Center Square	Light	(1) 2" square
Round 1	Dark	(2) 2 1/4" squares
Round 2	Light	(2) 2 3/4" squares
Round 3	Dark	(2) 3 1/4" squares

Block with 4 rounds or zippie bag 2

Layer	Fabric	Cut
Center Square	Dark	(1) 1 1/2" square
Round 1	Light	(2) 2" squares
Round 2	Dark	(2) 2 1/4" squares
Round 3	Light	(2) 2 3/4" squares
Round 4	Dark	(2) 3 1/4" squares
