2-501 Four Patch Square Up Tool[®] And you thought making a four patch unit was so easy. Well, it is with the Studio 180 Design Four Patch Square Up[®] tool. Here is your opportunity to create perfect alignment with each of the edges and seams of a four patch unit. You will create units slightly oversized and square them up to perfection.

Required Tool: Four Patch Square Up[®] Tool

Required Design Sheet: Four Patch Square Up

*These items can be purchased at your local quilt shop

Basic Sewing Supplies

Sewing Machine with
power cords and manual (just in case)
Thread
Machine needles
Snips or trimming scissors
Seam ripper

Basic Quilting Supplies

Rotary cutter with a sharp blade
Marking Pencil (mechanical will do)
Small cutting mat
Straight edge ruler approx. 6" x 12" or so
Invisigrip (Optional)
Best Press or light starch (Optional)

Fabric Requirements:

Bring a minimum of three different coordinating fabrics in which you can cut at least (2) strips of fabric that would measure 2 3/4" by the width of the fabric (WOF) or about 40-42".

Toss in a few additional pieces of fabric or additional fabric of the above three pieces. Your fabric requirements will be individual amounts depending upon your design.

NOTE: Please bring your entire Studio 180 Design "tool box" or tools and instructions. There will be a portion of the instruction in which you may decide to use your favorite tool and you will want to have it on hand.

P.S. Please label your tools with your name. My secret is to label my tool on the back side. I write my name backwards so that I can read my name when I read the tool. Then I cover the tool with the Invisigrip and it protects my name as well.
