Fabric Selection

Fabric Requirements

Based on 40" of usable fabric.

Accent (Teal)	% yard	1¼ yards	
Dark (Purple)	21/8 yards	3% yards	
Multi	1% yards	21/8 yards	
Background (White)	3¾ yards	6 yards	
Binding	% yard	% yard	
Backing	4¾ yards	9 yards	

Supplies

- Cutting Mat
- Rotary Cutter
- Seam Ripper
- Ruler (Wedge Star, ruler with a 45 Degree angle & 8 1/2" (or larger) square-up ruler or Tucker Trimmer 3)
- Sewing Machine (in good working order)
- Invisagrip (preferred for the back of Wedge Star Tool)

Prior to Class – Please cut required number of strips for each color (depending on which size quilt you will be making).

Cutting Instructions

Note: wof stands for width of fabric.

Accent (Teal)	— Diamond Four Patch	Cut 10 strips 2½" x wof.	Cut 18 strips 2¾" x wo£
Dark (Purple)	Diamond Four Patch	Cut 10 strips 2¼" x wof.	Cut 18 strips 21/2 x wol.
	Small Wedges	Cut 9 strips 5%" x wof; sub-cut into 144 Wedges using the 5%" line of the Wedge cutting section on the Wedge Star" tool. ‡	Cut 16 strips 5¼" x wof; sub-cut into 256 Wedges using the 5¼" line of the Wedge cutting section on the Wedge Star" tool, ‡
Multi	Diamonds	Cut 11 strips 3%" x wof; sub-cut into 72 Diamonds. #	Cut 19 strips 3¾" x wof; sub-cut into 128 Diamonds. ‡
Background	Small Wedges	Cut 8 strips 5¾" x wof; sub-cut into 120 Wedges using the 5¾" line of the Wedge cutting section on the Wedge Star* tool ‡	Cut 14 strips 54° x wof; sub-cut into 224 Wedges using the 54" line of the Wedge cutting section on the Wedge Star" tool. 4
	Corner Triangles	Cut 5 strips 6" x wof; sub-cut into 30 squares 6" x 6". Cut once diagonally to yield 60 triangles.	Cut 10 strips 6" x wof; sub-cut into 56 squares 6" x 6". Cut once diagonally to yield 112 triangles.
	Setting Pieces	Cut 6 strips 4½ x wof.	Cut 8 strips 4½" x wof.
	Borders*	Cut 8 strips 3½" x wof; piece to make: 2 strips 3½" x 68½". 2 strips 3½" x 74½".	Cut 11 strips 336" x wof; piece to make: 2 strips 336" x 91". 2 strips 336" x 97".
Dark (Purple)	Binding	Cut 2¼" strips by preferred method and piece to make 316" of binding.	Cut 2¼" strips by preferred method and piece to make 404" of binding.
