“Beginning Quilting” Supply List

Finished Quilt Size: 52” x 76”

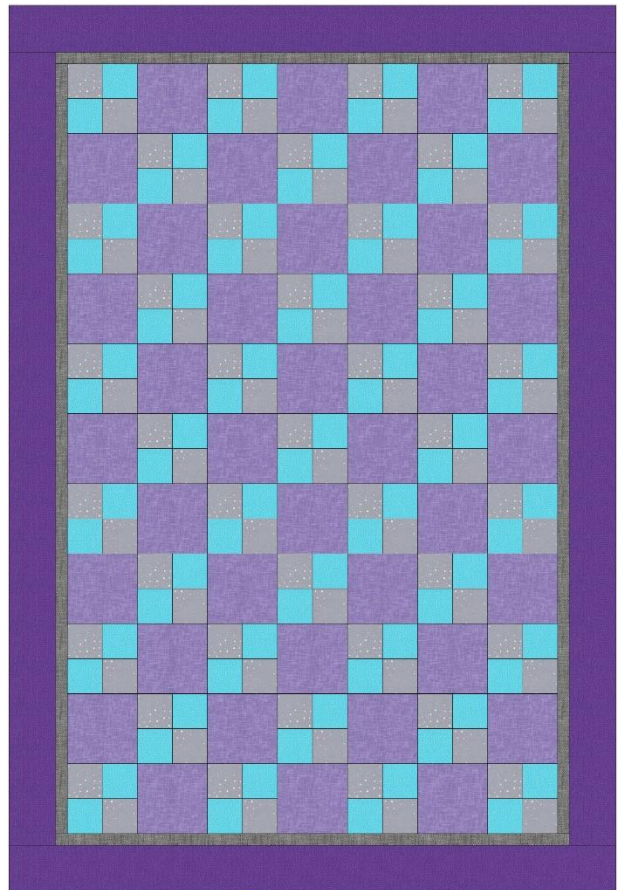
Learn to quilt using fast cutting and machine piecing techniques. Learn about fabric, thread, basic cutting and piecing skills. This class will cover how to make a quilt top and more! Whether you are just starting or want to sharpen your skills, We will provide you with expert guidance to make you a more confident quilter.

Fabric Requirements (For the lap size listed – see pattern for other sizes)

- Fabric “A” 1 yard (four-patch blocks)
- Fabric “B” 1 yard (four-patch blocks)
- Fabric “C” 1 ½ yards (focus fabric)
- Inside border: 3/8 yard
- Outside Border: 1 yard
- Binding: 1/2 yd - we will not be binding in class, but you may want to pre-purchase it to match your quilt top
- Backing: 3 1/2yds

Supply List

- *Easy Four-Patch Pattern* (Available at Cotton & Chocolate)
- Sewing Machine in top working order with instruction manual
- Schmetz sewing machine needles, Microtex Sharp 80/12 or Quilting 75/11
- Neutral color thread for piecing (grey, ecru or white) Mettler or Aurifil 50 wt
- Acrylic rulers 6 ½” x 24” and 6 ½” x 12 ½” (optional but helpful 6 ½” square) I recommend Creative Grids or Quilter’s Select rulers
- Rotary cutter with new blade
- Cutting mat 18” x 24” is a good size to start off
- Sharp fine straight pins, flat flower or with glass heads
- Scissors and seam ripper
- ¼” patchwork foot, if you have one
- Chair cushion if you would like to sit higher for sewing in class
- Paper and pencil if you wish to take notes.



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
