"Color Wash" Supply List

Want a great strip piecing project that is perfect for FAST sewing? Color washing the jelly roll strip set is pretty easy and has consistently cool results! Take a jelly roll and join me in making your own color wash creation. This skinny strip Rail Fence pattern is beginner friendly and far easier than it looks.

Quilt size is typically around 48"x54" and will vary depending on your jelly roll and border choices.





Supply List

- One jelly roll with 40 fabric 2-1/2" strips with some gradation of color (typically 2 of each color)
- Additional fabric will be required for optional borders, plus backing and binding.
- Sewing Machine in top working order with 1/4" patchwork foot and instruction manual
- Schmetz sewing machine needles, Microtex Sharp 80/12 or Quilting 75/11
- Neutral color thread for piecing (grey, ecru or white) Mettler or Aurifil 50 wt
- Acrylic rulers 6 ½" x 24" and 6 ½" x 12 ½" (optional but helpful 6 ½" square) I recommend Creative Grids or Quilter's Select rulers
- Rotary cutter with new blade
- Cutting mat (optionally you can use the shop cutting mats)
- Sharp fine straight pins, flat flower or with glass heads
- Scissors and seam ripper
- Chair cushion if you would like to sit higher for sewing in class
