

Filigree

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Have you ever wanted to make a Snail's Trail quilt? If so, then this quilt's for you! Filigree is a unique variation on a traditional Snail's Trail block. Instead of a four patch in the center, there are two pointy triangles giving you inter-locking twists - a unique effect reminding us of filigree scrollwork. With the addition of the Corner Beam units between the Snail's Trail blocks you have even more spiky interest!

Fabric Selection

Fabric Requirements

Based on 40" of usable fabric with few cutting errors. Please plan accordingly.

Fabric	Lap	Twin	Queen
Scrappy Whites (background)	2¼ yds.	3% yds.	5% yds.
Scrappy Pinks (dark/medium)	2 yds.	3¼ yds.	4% yds.
Inner Border	% yd.	% yd.	% yd.
Outer Border/Binding	2 yds.	3 yds.	3½ yds.
Backing	4 yds.	6 yds.	9 yds.

Supplies

- Cutting Mat (larger size, such as 18" x 24" preferred)
- Corner Beam and Large Square Squared Tools
- Rotary Cutter
- Reverse Sewing Tool (Seam Ripper)
- Sewing Machine (in good working order)
