Scrappy Heart Supply List

Quilt Size: 48" x 55"
Teacher: Jerry Petersen

This lovely quilt was designed by Margie Fisher, who was the very first owner of the current Cotton & Chocolate Quilt Company, though at that time it was called "The Quilt Inn".

This quilt is meant to be scrappy. You are not limited by the 13 fabrics suggested below. You can always add more for a really "scrappy" quilt.

Fabric requirements:

13 - 9" x 22" pieces (i.e., fat-eighths), or about 1-3/4 yards total of assorted dark fabrics for the center heart. Again, you can use more than 13 fabrics if desired. You will be cutting them into 1-1/4" and 2" wide strips and then cross-cutting into smaller rectangles 8" long or less.

16 - 9" x 22" pieces (i.e., fat-eighths), or about 2-1/2 yards total for the background. Again, you can use more than 16 fabrics if desired. For the center heart blocks, you will be cutting them into 1-1/4" and 2" wide strips and then cross-cutting into smaller rectangles 8" long or less for the center heart blocks. Some of these light fabrics will be used for inner border background and will be cut at either 3" wide or 3-1/2" wide.

1 yard for the outer border

1/2 yard for the binding. If you want to make the binding the same as your outer border, a 1-1/2 yard piece will be enough to be able to cut your border strips length-of-fabric (LOF) so there will be no seams.

Backing: 3-1/4 yards.

Pattern Required: Scrappy Heart by Hot Chocolate Press

Basic quilting tools:

- Rotary cutting tool and matt
- Ruler for cutting strips
- Thread clipper
- Sewing machine and piecing thread
- Seam ripper, etc.
