### ***Smooth Sailing***

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This stunning take on the traditional Storm at Sea quilt layout was designed by Pam Goggans of Sager Creek Quilts & Yarnworks. Created by Studio 180 Design's Diamond Rects and Square 2 (Square Squared) tools, you can be sure that when you piece your very own Storm at Sea project, it'll be smooth sailing from the start to finish.

**\*\*Pattern required – Smooth Sailing by Studio 180 Design's**

Fabric Requirements:

<b>Fabric</b>	<b>Throw</b>	<b>Queen</b>
<b>Assorted Lights</b>	8 Fat Quarters	24 -26 Fat Quarters
<b>Assorted Darks</b>	8 Fat Quarters	20 Fat Quarters
<b>Accent Fabric/Border #1 (Dark)</b>	$\frac{7}{8}$ Yard	1½ Yards
<b>Border #2</b>	1 Yard	1 5/8 Yards
<b>Backing</b>	3 Yards	8 Yards
<b>Binding</b>	$\frac{3}{8}$ Yard	1 Yard

### **Supplies**

- Cutting Mat (larger size, such as 18" x 24" preferred)
- Ruler
- Diamond Rect Tool by Deb Tucker
- Square Squared Tool by Deb Tucker
- Rotary Cutter
- Seam Ripper
- Sewing Machine (in good working order)

### **Prior to Class**

Please precut each fat quarter per number requested in pattern (realize that the number listed is the total quantity needed – not the number needed for each color) and baggies for each size:

- 3 ¼" x 20" Lights (do not cut into Diamond Shapes before class)
- 4 ¼" Lights (do not cut diagonally before class)
- 3 ½" Lights
- 2 ¾" Lights (do not cut diagonally before class)
- 2 ¼" Lights
- 2" square Lights
- 4 ¼" Darks (do not cut diagonally before class)
- 2 ¾" Darks (do not cut diagonally before class)
- 2 ¾" x 4" Darks (do not cut rectangles diagonally before class)
- Accent Color (all pieces can be put into this baggie)
  - 3 ¾" squares
  - 2 ¾" x 4" (do not cut rectangles diagonally before class)
  - 3 ½" squares

\*Note – The Light colors will be tight when cutting, so please plan out your cutting

\*\*You might want to bring practice fabric to class in varies color/patterns to practice using the tools before using fabric from your kit (if purchased).
