## **Tooth and Nail Supply List**

In this class you will create a lap sized quilt using large blocks. I will show some techniques for making the half square triangles (HST) and flying geese units that are different from the pattern instructions. The quilt is fat quarter friendly except for the background and accent fabrics.

## Supplies for 64" X 80" quilt

- Pattern: Tooth and Nail by Victoria Findley Wolfe
- Fabric:
- Background: (mine is the black and white print, this is no longer available in black, but it
  is available in gray.) 2 yards
- Accent: (mine is black solid) 2 ½ yards
- o Blocks: (20) fat quarters) there is one/block
- Binding: 2/3 yard
- Backing: 5 yards (the seam will be horizontal)
- Other materials:
- 2 ½" Blok-Lok square (or larger), Or 2" finished triangle papers, I recommend Star Singles by Spinning Star Design for this project (you will need 30 papers and there are 100 in each pack so maybe share with a friend or two.)
- Wing Clipper by Deb Tucker (for flying geese units) If you don't own this, let me know before class so that I can give you alternate cutting instructions.
- Sewing machine in good working order
- 100 % cotton thread in a neutral color for piecing (Mettler, Aurifil or DMC)
- Machine bobbins in same color
- o Rotary cutter and 18" X 24" mat
- o 6" X 12" ruler and 6" X 24" ruler (these are minimums, the rulers may be larger)
- Thread clippers
- Seam ripper, I will unsew for you in class, but you may need one at home)
- o Fine, straight pins
- o A sense of humor for class-machine piecing can be tricky, so don't let it get to you.
