

Basket Case Quilt by Cluck Cluck Sew

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This is such a well-written pattern and I so excited to try it!

The pressing instructions are key (and I added one of my own tricks) to making these blocks nest so nicely together at each seam. The block construction is very simple, but looks harder as it makes a woven pattern much like a basket weave.

Follow the pattern fabric requirements to choose which size you would like to make. My sample did not use all the strips in my 2 ½” roll as some were too light. My layout is 5 blocks x 6 blocks. I added borders per a request, however... if you want your quilt to truly have a woven look, then you don't need a border (see pattern).

Supplies:

- **Basket Case** quilt pattern by Cluck Cluck Sew
- 2 ½” strips (the amount will vary according to the size you make. You can use a roll of pre-cuts, or....cut from your own “stash”).
- Background fabric (check pattern for amount)
- I recommend bringing some type of markers (stickers or small post-its to label A and B blocks. I just used red and green little circles).

Other Supplies:

- Rotary cutter and cutting mat
- Cutting ruler, whatever size is comfortable
- Scissors, pins, ripper etc.
- Sewing machine in good working order
