In this class, you will learn how to cut and sew together a quilt top. You will need to do homework between classes in order to complete your quilt top

**Required Supplies:**

- ❖ First-Time Quiltmaking- book by Landauer Books
- ❖ Sewing Machine in top working order with instruction manual
- ❖ Schmetz sewing machine needles, Microtex Sharp 80/12 or Quilting 75/11
- ❖ Neutral color thread for piecing (grey, ecru or white ) Mettler or Aurifil 50 wt
- ❖ Acrylic rulers 6 ½" x 24 1/2" and 6 ½" x 12 ½" (optional but helpful 6 ½" square)
- ❖ I recommend Creative Grids rulers
- ❖ Rotary cutter with new blade
- ❖ Cutting mat 18" x 24" is a good size to start off
- ❖ Sharp fine straight pins, flat flower or with glass heads
- ❖ Scissors and seam ripper
- ❖ ¼" patchwork foot, if you have one
- ❖ Chair cushion if you would like to sit higher for sewing in class
- ❖ Paper and pencil if you wish to take notes

**Please mark all your tools with your name or initials. Be on time and come prepared.**

**Fabric:**

Fabric "A" 5/8 yard (four-patch blocks)

Fabric "B" 5/8 yard (four-patch blocks)

Fabric "C" 1 ½ yards (focus fabric)

Inside border: 1/2 yard

Outside Border: 1 ½ yards or 2 ½ yards if directional

\*Binding: 5/8 yd \*we will not be binding in class, but you may want to pre-purchase it to match your quilt top

Backing: 3 1/2yds
