SUPPLY LIST BEGINNING QUILTING

Welcome to the world of quilting! In this class, you will learn how to cut and sew together a quilt top using four patches and squares. To complete your quilt top, you will need to do homework in between classes.

Required Supplies:

- *Start Quilting with Alex Anderson*, published by C & T Publishing
- Sewing machine in top working order with its instruction manual.
- Schmetz Microtex (Sharp) or Jeans sewing machine needles 80/12 or 75/11
- Good quality 100% cotton thread; i.e. Mettler, Aurifil, or DMC, to blend with your fabrics. (I recommend using grey, ecru, khaki or white.)
- 6" X 24" acrylic ruler and 6" X 12" (these are minimum sizes, 6 ½" x 24 ½" and 6 ½" X 12 ½" are fine).
- Rotary cutter with new blade
- Cutting mat (at least 22" on one side) this is for home use, we will use the shop mats in class.
- Glass head pins (these should be very fine) with a pincushion-if you don't have one, you might want a magnetic one to start with.
- Scissors
- Thread clippers
- Seam ripper
- Chair cushion if you would like to sit higher for sewing in class.
- *Notepad/paper and pen or pencil for taking notes (*optional)

PLEASE MARK ALL OF YOUR TOOLS BEFORE CLASS-IT'S EASY TO GET THEM MIXED UP.

FABRIC:

Fabric "A": 1 yard (small squares)
Fabric "B": 1 yard (small squares)
Fabric "C": 1 ½ yards (larger alternate squares)
Inside Border: 5/8 yard
Outside Border: 1 ½ yards or 2 ½ yards if directional
*Binding: 5/8 yard
Backing: 3 ¾ yards

(*We won't be binding in class, but you might want to pre-purchase it to match your quilt top.)
