Do you have the book Farm Girl Vintage, but can't decide what to do next with it? Well here's the class for you. You can make this cute table runner. Lots of fun to mix and match different blocks and make something your own.

Book Required: Farm Girl Vintage by Lori Holt

Fabric: I used 6 different fat quarters (including the background) to make this fun runner.

- 1 fat quarter for background
- 1 fat quarter for barn with silo, tractor
- 1 fat quarter for tractor, parts of barn
- 1 fat quarter for quilty barn
- 1 fat quarter for roof, silo
- 1 fat quarter for wheels.

I used scraps from my stash to make the 2 barn doors, you'll need to decide which 2 blocks from the book you want in your barn. You'll also need a fat eighth of green for barns.

Supplies: Sewing machine, rotary cutter, rulers thread, seam ripper, usual supplies.

Optional Supplies: Folded Corner Clipper, Pressing Stick
