Camp Stitchalot Bag

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This is a great bag for bringing a smaller mat and some basic supplies back and forth to class.
Use fun fabrics that will make you smile!

Supplies

Pattern: Camp Stitchalot Bag, download from the Sew Sweetness website by Sara Lawson

Fabric:

- 1 ½ yards of Exterior fabric
- 1 ½ yards of Lining fabric
- 1 yard for Back Pocket
- ½ yard for Binding OR, 3 yards of pre-made Bias binding to match your fabric (This is for the vinyl pockets and the outside of the bag)
- 3 yards of Pellon® SF-101 Shape Flex® fusible woven interfacing
- ¾ yard of By Annie's Soft and Stable®
- ¾ yard of Peltex #70 sew-in interfacing, or another extra firm sew-in interfacing
- 1 ½ yards of 54" wide 8 gauge (or 0.5mm) clear vinyl
- (4) 18" regular zippers in colors to match your fabrics
- (4) ½" magnetic snaps; or substitute Velcro

Additional Supplies and Materials

- Sewing machine in good working order
- Sewing machine needles (I recommend Jeans 80/12 or 90/14 if using heavier fabrics)
- 100% Cotton thread
- Filled bobbins
- Rotary cutter and mat (you may use the shop mats in class)
- 6" X 12" and 6" X 12" rulers
- Thread clippers
- Seam ripper
- Fine, straight pins
- Zipper foot for your machine
- Walking Foot for your machine
- *Optional: nylon or Teflon foot for sewing the plastic
- Pressing cloth
- Fabric marker
- Wonder clips
