Fabric Selection

Fabric Requirements

Based on 40% of usable fabric with few cutting errors. Please plan accordingly.

Fabric	Yardage
Dark Purple	1 1/2 yards
Medium Purple	1 3/4 yards
Light Purple	3/4 yard
Accent (Teal)	1/2 yard
Background	2 3/4 yards
Inner Border	1/2 yard
Outer Border & Binding	2 1/4 yards
Buckram	5 yards

Supplies

- Cutting Mat (larger size, such as 18" x 24" preferred)
- Wedge Star and Tucker Trimmer III Tools
- Rotary Cutter
- Reverse Sewing Tool (Seam Ripper)
- Sewing Machine (in good working order)

Cutting Instructions

Note: wof stands for width of fabric.

Fabric	Unit	Cut
Dark Purple	Diamonds†	Cut 11 strips 3" x wof.
	Large Wedges†	Cut 4 strips 7" x wof;
Medium Purple	Corner Triangles	Cut 3 strips 4¾" x wof; sub-cut into 24 squares 4¾" x 4¾"
	Large Wedges†	Cut 1 strip 7" x wof.
Light Purple	Corner Triangles	Sub-cut 2 squares 4¾" x 4¾" from the remainder of the 7" strip;
	Small Wedges†	Cut 2 strips 4½" x wof.
Accent (Teal)	Corner Triangles	Cut 3 strips 4¾" x wof; sub-cut into 24 squares 4¾" x 4¾"
Background	Large Wedges†	Cut 6 strips 7" x wof.
	Small Wedges†	Cut 8 strips 4½" x wof.
Inner Border		Cut/piece 2 strips 2½" x 60½"
		Cut/piece 2 strips 2½" x 64½"
Outer Border		Cut/piece 2 strips 5½" x 64½"
		Cut/piece 2 strips 5½" x 74½"
Binding		Cut 2¼" strips by preferred method and piece to make 316" of binding.

Class Preparation

Please cut your fabrics according to the chart provided and put them in individual baggies - labeled by unit type (i.e. Diamonds, Large Wedges, Corner Triangles, etc.).
