## Supply List for FINISH IT

**In this class, you will learn how to pin baste your quilt, machine quilt using your walking foot and add binding**

### Required Supplies:

- ❖ Your finished quilt top
- ❖ Backing fabric ( sewn together to be at least 2" larger than your quilt top )
- ❖ Batting ( at least 2" larger on all sides than your quilt top)
- ❖ Sewing Machine in top working order with instruction manual
- ❖ Walking Foot that fits your make and model machine ( also referred to as an even-feed foot or dual feed)
- ❖ Schmetz sewing machine needles, Microtex Sharp 80/12 or Quilting 75/11
- ❖ Good quality 100% cotton thread in a color that blends with your quilt top and that matches your backing and binding.
- ❖ Acrylic rulers 6 ½" x 24 ½" and 6 ½" x 12 ½"
- ❖ Rotary cutter with new blade
- ❖ Cutting mat \*Shop mats are available for you to use\*
- ❖ 300 or more #1 safety pins for basting your quilt, curved ones are nice! Straight ones are just fine but you really need a lot of them!
- ❖ Quik Clip tool for pin-basting (optional)
- ❖ Scissors and seam ripper
- ❖ ¼" patchwork foot, if you have one
- ❖ Chair cushion if you would like to sit higher for sewing in class
- ❖ Paper and pencil if you wish to take notes
