In this class you will learn how to pin baste your quilt, machine quilt your quilt using a walking foot, and add binding, the finishing touch!

Required Supplies:

- Sewing machine in top working order with its instruction manual.
- Walking foot* to fit your sewing machine (*also known as an even-feed foot)
- Schmetz Topstitch sewing machine needles 90/14
- Finished quilt top
- Batting (at least 2" larger on all sides than your quilt top)
- Backing fabric-pieced to be at least 2" larger on all sides than your quilt top
- Good quality 100% cotton thread; i.e. Mettler, Aurifil, or DMC, to blend with your binding fabric and something to match your backing fabric for the bobbin
- Machine quilting thread to match your quilt top
- 6" X 24" acrylic ruler (this is a minimum size, 6 ½" x 24 ½" or larger is fine). (for second class)
- Rotary cutter with new blade (for second class)
- We will trim your quilt in the second class, so we will use the shop's cutting mats
- ~ 500 (or more) #1 safety pins-I prefer brass, since they won't tarnish, but whatever you have will work (I'm not kidding, honest!)
- Binding fabric to match or coordinate with your quilt top (for second class)
- Thread clippers
- Seam ripper
- Chair cushion if you would like to sit higher for sewing in class.
- Notepad/paper and pen or pencil for taking notes

PLEASE MARK ALL OF YOUR TOOLS BEFORE CLASS-IT'S EASY TO GET THEM MIXED UP.
