

Four Generations Supply List

The fabrics listed make a quilt of 30-10" blocks, approximately 50" X 60". If you wish to make yours larger or smaller, adjust the fabrics accordingly.

Supplies:

- Book, *I Love House Blocks*, from That Patchwork Place, Martingale Publishing (if you can get it, otherwise, the pattern for this quilt will be given out in class.
- Sewing Machine in good working order
- Sewing Machine needles, 80/12 Microtex or Jeans
- Thread to blend with fabric
- Seam ripper-just in case
- Thread clippers
- Fine, straight pins
- Acrylic rulers, 6" X 12" and 6" X 24"
- Cutting mat, 18" X 24"
- Rotary cutter
- Corner clipper Ruler©, if you already have one

Fabrics:

- Background-2 ¼ yards
- Blocks (houses and alternate blocks)-15 fat quarters, use more if you want a 'scrappier' look. I used more in my sample quilt.
- Binding-5/8 yard
- Backing-3 ½ yards
