## Heirloom Sewing Techniques Level I

Heirloom Sewing Techniques, Level I, long used for infant, children, and adult clothing, can also be used as a technique for quilts and quilted projects. We will use the finest Swiss fabric, embroideried, and French laces while learning the Level 1 techniques: French Seams, Flat Fabric to Entredeaux, Lace to Fabric, Lace to Entredeaux, Lace to Lace Lace inserts, and puffing. These techniques can be adapted to all types of sewing and can add creativity to your work!

There is a \$15 kit fee to cover the Swiss voile, French edging, French insertion, & Swiss entredeaux.

Supplies:

Sewing machine in working order that stitches straight and zigzag, extra bobbins, ¼ inch foot, edge foot, and 3 groove pintuck foot or regular buttonhole foot (NOT the long electronic foot on a spring)if you have them. It helps if your machine can move needle positions to the right and to the left.

Madeira Cotona 80 wt. thread, 60 Microtex Sharp needle, 60 Universal Needle. If you can't find Madeira Cotona 80 wt. let me know (805-529-5005) and I will bring you a spool.

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
