Hexie Garden Quilt Supply List

Over a four month period we will make 9 whimsical hexagon blocks that are comprised of both appliqué and piecing. Mine are made using fusible, raw-edge appliqué and that is the technique that I will teach in class. Of course, you are free to use any other appliqué technique that you prefer. Every month we will focus on three blocks and plan the final layout during the last month.

Supplies Needed:

- Pattern: "Hexie Garden Quilt" by Becky Goldsmith
- One sheet of template plastic
- Sharpie pen or marker (to mark on template plastic)
- Fusible web (if using this method)
- Thread for appliqué (to match fabric)
- Rotary cutter and mat (you can use one of the shop mats while working at the class)
- Fine, straight pins
- Light box (if you have one) – I will bring one to use in class
- Sewing machine with open toe appliqué foot

Fabric:

- Block Background Fabric: 3-3/8 yards if using the same fabric for all blocks – OR – 1/2 yard per block if using a different fabric for each of the 9 blocks
- Flower Fabrics: Variety of large scraps for all of the flowers, leaves and stems and English Paper Pieced flowers
- Green Block Centers: 1/3 yard if you use the same fabric for all block centers – OR- 1/8 yard per block if you use a different fabric for each block
- Block Accent Fabrics: 5/8 yard if you use the same fabric for each block –OR – 1/8 yard per block if you use a different fabric for each block.
- Setting Triangles and Outer Borders: 2 3/4 yards
- Binding: 1 yard

If made as pictured, the finished size of the quilt is: 61 1/2" x 69 3/4"

Prior to class: Please do not do any cutting prior to class. We will be working on blocks 1, 2 and 3. Work on planning your fabrics for these first 3 blocks and bring the fabrics for these blocks (bring some alternates, too). Of course, we will audition your fabrics and see if they work prior to making final decisions. I changed my mind....that is just a part of the process!!!
