In this class, you will make an art quilt of a hummingbird feeding on flowers. You will be taught how to do fusible web machine raw edge appliqué to piece together the bird and the flowers.

Size: 30x20 inches

Pattern Required: Hummingbird Garden by Janet Abravaya

Supplies:

Sewing machine

Darning foot

Rotary cutter, ruler and cutting board

Fabric scissors and paper scissors

Paperbacked fusible web

Applique` pressing sheet

Basting spray

Monofilament thread

Cotton thread matching backing fabric; also threads matching appliqué fabrics if you will be quilting on the appliqué.

Fabric & Batting

Background – 1 yard

Backing – 1 yard

Binding – ¼ yard

Flowers – fat quarter

Hummingbird:

Light gray – fat quarter

Gray – fat quarter

Brown – fat quarter

Red – 5x7 inch rectangle

Green – scrap 6x1 inches

Black – scrap 2x2 inches

Batting – 36x26 inches

Prior to Class – Please trace all pattern pieces onto fusible web paper backing. Mark each piece with its letter.
