



## INDIAN SUMMER

The design for this quilt unfolded as a surprise for my sister-in-law who always takes me to various quilt shops when I visit her in Anchorage, Alaska. I came home after one trip with several fabrics she admired. The design I created used all of the "Alaska" fabrics and some more from my own "stash". Since Jen is now the owner of the original quilt, I made a second one to keep for teaching purposes. I'd always wanted to make a purple and gold quilt. I've gone on to make it in several different combinations. Yours can be in colors that you love!

This quilt finishes at approximately 65 ½" x 92 ½"

### **Supplies:**

- **Indian Summer** quilt pattern (sold at C&CQC)
- 2 yds. Of a Focus fabric for blocks and outside border
- 1 yd. Of a second Focus fabric for blocks
- ½ yd. of a contrasting fabric for block corners
- ½ yd. EACH of FIVE different fabrics for block frame
- 1/3 yd. of a dark fabric for cornerstones
- 2 ¼ yds. Of a light fabric for sashing units and inner border
- 1 yd. of a dark/med. dark fabric for sashing units

You can also refer to the pattern to see where your choices will be placed.

### **Other Supplies:**

- Rotary cutter and cutting mat
- 9 ½" square ruler (or larger is fine)
- 6" x 12" or 6" x 24" ruler (whatever you use)
- Scissors, pins, ripper etc.
- Sewing machine in good working order.
