### Supplies

Sewing machine in good working order

Thread and bobbin appropriate for the fabrics you have chosen

Ruler

Pins

Scissors

Pencil

Rotary cutter and mat

A 2-yard cut of flannel or a flannel-backed picnic tablecloth as a “design wall”

### FABRIC REQUIREMENTS

A “layer cake” (a set of forty 10” squares from a fabric line) or assorted fabrics from your stash, enough to cut 40 10” squares.

Coordinating solid or tone-on-tone fabrics, each large enough to cut at least eight 2 ½” squares. You will need twenty sets of eight squares. (You can cut two sets from a 2 ½” WOF strip, or from a 10” square.)

Border fabrics:

(You may want to wait until the quilt center is pieced to choose these.)

Inner border            1/2 yard

Outer border 1        5/8 yard

Outer border 2        5/8 yard
