1-1301 Migrating Geese We don't want anyone to get lost as our geese migrate, so learn how to make migrating geese as a variation of the flying geese. Without the use of any required tools you will soon find a flock of migrating geese near you. You will be incorporating migrating geese into borders and sashing everywhere because you will not be able to get enough of these guys.

Required technique sheet: Migrating Geese
Suggested tool: Quilter's Magic Wand

Basic Sewing Supplies

Sewing Machine with
power cords and manual (just in case)
Thread
Machine needles
Snips or trimming scissors
Seam ripper

Basic Quilting Supplies

Rotary cutter with a sharp blade
Marking Pencil (Mechanical will do)
Small cutting mat
Straight edge ruler approx. 6" x 12" or so
Best Press or light starch (Optional)

Fabric Requirements:

Cut from the background fabric:
(14) 3 7/8" squares

Cut from a variety of your non-background fabrics as long as there is a contrast with the background fabric:

(7) 4 1/4" squares*

*You have options:

If you want to cut each square from a different fabric, you will get a scrappy effect.

If you want to use just two different fabrics; your will have a strong repeating pattern.

If you want to cut all of the squares from one fabric, you will have a very uniform effect.
