Rangeley Wall Quilt

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The project received its name because the streamlined construction for the star points— using the Deb Tucker “Tucker Trimmer” - was conceived while Deb Tucker worked at a quilt retreat in Rangeley, Maine! The wall quilt features a pieced 17” central star block surrounded by a cluster of 14 smaller stars in the borders. Deb’s techniques and tools make this difficult looking project simple to construct. Shhh - we won’t tell anyone how easy it is to make!

FABRIC SUPPLIES:

The quilt can be made with as few as 4 fabrics, or it can be made “scrappy” by using multiple fabrics for any of the listed fabrics.

All yardage is based on 40” of usable fabric with few cutting errors.
Please plan your purchases accordingly.

STAR POINT FABRIC(S)	3/4	YD
ACCENT FABRIC	1/4 to 1/2	YD
BACKGROUND FABRIC(S)	1 1/3	YDS
BINDING	3/8	YD
BACKING	1 1/3	YDS
BATTING	38” x 48”	

ADDITIONAL RECOMMENDED TOOLS “TUCKER TRIMMER” AND “QUILTER’S MAGIC WAND”

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Supplies

- Cutting Mat (larger size, such a 18" x 24" preferred)
- Ruler
- Tucker Trimmer I Ruler by Studio 180 Design
- Rotary Cutter
- Seam Ripper
- Sewing Machine (in good working order)

Prior to Class

- Please precut fabrics, per pattern directions, placing each block components into separate baggies (i.e. Half Square Triangles, V-Blocks, Squares, Corner Setting Triangles and Borders).
