Fabric Selection

Fabric Requirements

Based on 40” of usable fabric with few cutting errors. Please plan accordingly.

Fabric	Yardage
Assorted Colors	Six 2½” x width of fabric strips
Background/Binding	1¼ yards
Backing	1¼ yard (pieced)
Batting	20” x 55”

Supplies

- Cutting Mat (larger size, such as 18” x 24” preferred)
- Diamond Rects Tool
- Rotary Cutter
- Reverse Sewing Tool (Seam Ripper)
- Sewing Machine (in good working order)

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
