Deb's Wing Clipper and Corner Beam tools ensure perfect units for easy quilt construction and so all you need to do is add those beautiful fabrics.

Fabric Selection

Fabric Requirements

Based on 40" of usable fabric with few cutting errors. Please plan accordingly.

Fabric	Wall	Table Runner
Dark Scraps	1¼ yards total	½ yard total
Light Background	1½ yards	¾ yard
Dark Frame	-----	¼ yard
Border & Binding	1¼ yards	⅝ yard

**I used 9 different fabrics to come up with the Dark Scraps. Since there are 9 different parts to each leaf, it made it easy to have each leaf different than each other.

Supplies

- Cutting Mat (larger size, such as 18" x 24" preferred)
- Wing Clipper and Corner Beam (and Square Squared – if doing the Wall Hanging) Tools
- Rotary Cutter
- Seam Ripper
- Sewing Machine (in good working order)

Class Preparation

Please cut your fabrics according to the chart provided and put them in individual baggies - labeled by unit type (i.e. Flying Geese, Quicket, Corner Beam, etc).

Dark Fabric Scraps - 1¼ yards total		
Flying Geese units	18 squares	4½" square
Quicket units	27 squares	4½" square
Square ^{2"} units	4 squares	4½" cut to size with Square ^{2"} tool
Corner Beam ["] units	9 squares	4" cut to shape with Corner Beam ["] tool
Leaf Centers	9 squares	2" square
Light Background - 1¼ yards total		
Flying Geese units	72 squares	2½" square
Quicket units	27 squares	2½" square
Leaf Background	9 squares	3½" square
	18 rectangles	2" x 3½"
Corner Beam ["] units	9 pairs side triangles	4" strip cut with Corner Beam ["] tool
Square ^{2"} units	8 squares	2¾" cut in half on one diagonal
Border Strips	2 strips	3½" x 22½"
	2 strips	3½" x 12"
Borders & Binding - 1¼ yards total		
Inner Borders	2 strips	2½" x 26"
	2 strips	2½" x 30"
Outer Borders	2 strips	4" x 36"
	2 strips	4" x 43"
Binding	5 strips	2¼" x WOF

Table Runner - Yardage & Cutting Instructions		
Dark Fabric Scraps - ½ yard total		
Flying Geese units	8 squares	4½" square
Quicket units	9 squares	4½" square
Corner Beam ["] units	3 squares	4" cut to shape with Corner Beam ["] tool
Leaf Centers	3 squares	2" square
Light Background - ⅝ yard total		
Flying Geese units	32 squares	2½" square
Quicket units	9 squares	2½" square
Corner Beam ["] units	3 pairs side triangles	4" x 12" strip folded in half and cut with Corner Beam ["] tool
Leaf Background	3 squares	3½" square
	6 rectangles	2" x 3½"
Dark Frame - ¼ yards total		
Inner Borders	4 strips	2" x 11"
	4 strips	2" x 35"
Borders & Binding - ⅝ yards total		
Outer Borders	2 strips	3½" x 35"
	2 strips	3½" x 20"
Binding	3 strips	2¼" x WOF

Note: WOF stands for Width of Fabric.

**** For the Corner Beam Units, just come with the Strips cut. We can cut the Units in class.**
