

Tula's Neighborhood Supply List

I made 36 blocks for this quilt, the blocks are 9" X 9" finished, so it is a large throw quilt measuring about 71" X 71". The house portion of this quilt can be made with a 5" strip of fabric, or (2) can be made from a ¼ yard of fabric. Then you could use 1-6 fabrics for the roof, depending on how much variety you would like. So, I am including the cutting instructions (for 36 blocks) along with the fabric requirements.

Basic Sewing Materials

- Sewing machine in good working order with a new needle (80/10 Microtex)
- Neutral cotton thread
- Seam ripper
- Thread clippers
- Small cutting mat and rotary cutter
- Corner Clipper ruler (if you have one)
- Small acrylic ruler (3" X 12"; 5" X 10"; 4" X 12")
- Mechanical pencil
- Straight pins

Fabric Requirements: (I recommend marking the fabric before class, so you remember where you planned on using it.)

- "Sky" fabric: ¾ yard
 - Cut (7) 3 ½" X WOF strips
- "Roof" fabric: 1 ¼ yards if using only one fabric; (4) 1/3-yard cuts; or (6) fat quarters
 - Cut (4) 9 ½" X WOF strips; then, cut (36) 3 ½" X 9 ½" rectangles (*If using Fat Quarters, cut a 9 ½" strip, then (2) 3 ½" strips and crosscut to get the (36) 3 ½" X 9 ½", at least (6) from each FQ, rectangles you will need.)
- "Window": (1) 5" strip, or ¼ yard
 - Cut (2) 2" X WOF strips; then, cut (36) 2" X 2" squares
- "Door" fabric: ¼ yard; or may be cut from "House" fabric
 - Cut (2) 3 ½" X WOF strips; then, cut (36) 2" X 3 ½" rectangles (*If cutting from "house" fabric, cut from one of the 2" strips.)
- "Grass" fabric: 5/8 yard
 - Cut (2) 9 ½" X WOF strips; then, cut (36) 2" X 9 ½" rectangles
- "House" fabric: (1) 5" strip from (36) different fabrics, or (18) ¼ yard fabrics
 - If using a 5" strip, cut (1) 3 ½" piece from end first, crosscut that to make a 3 ½" X 4 ½" rectangle. Then, cut the remaining fabric into (2) 2" X WOF strips and cut:
 - (1) 2" X 9 ½" rectangle
 - (1) 2" X 4 ½" rectangle
 - (2) 2" X 1 5/8" rectangle
 - * if cutting door... (1) 2" X 3 ½" rectangle
- Sashing and Inner Border: 1 1/3 yard
- Cornerstones and Binding: ¾ yard
- Outer border: 1 yard
