Along with beautiful nightgowns sized from 18" dolls all the way up to XL Womens (3X!) Sweet Dreams also includes 3 different sizes of pockets - those for dolls, girls, and ladies - and 6 floral designs for each of those sizes, 18 pockets in all. The pockets shown are the girls' size but the tiny doll pockets would be really cute too. These pockets stitch entirely in the hoop with raw edges perfectly folded and ready to topstitch onto any project! They are perfect for customizing a plain shell top for yourself, or any other purchased or handmade clothing.
