

Hey – What’s in This Kit!

- White – 2 Jelly
- Red Floral – 1 Jelly
- Rose Floral – 1 Charm



Simple Irish Chain

These are not stand alone instructions
12" Finished Block

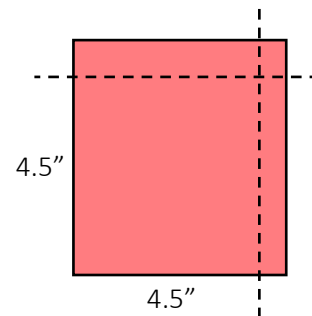
Charm = 5" Square, Cake = 10" Square, Jelly = 2.5" x WOF

Cutting Directions are written with rotary cutting in mind. You will need a 45mm Cutter, Rulers, and Self Healing Mat.

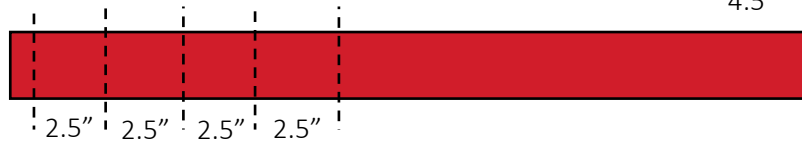
The Right Ruler For the Job!
I Love My Quilting Friends Ruler
and 6 1/2" square Ruler!

Cutting Directions:

Rose Floral– 1 Charm
Trim to 4.5" Square
Set Aside

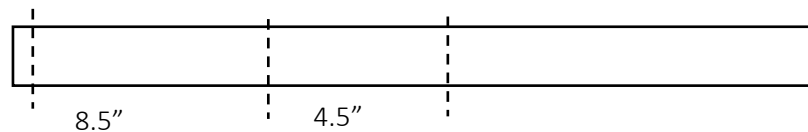


Red Floral – 1 Jelly (Keep Jelly Folded in Half)
Cut 8 (eight) 2.5" squares
4 Cuts for 8 squares.
Set Aside



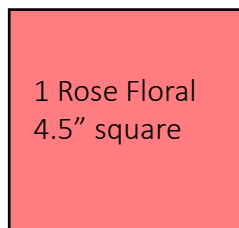
Stack the two white jelly (folded) before cutting

White – 2 Jelly (folded)
Cut 4 (four) 2.5" x 8.5"
Cut 4 (four) 2.5" x 4.5"



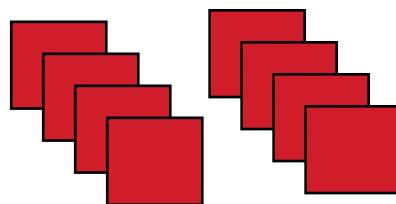
Best Practices: Always trim salvage off jelly strips!

Summary of Cut Pieces:



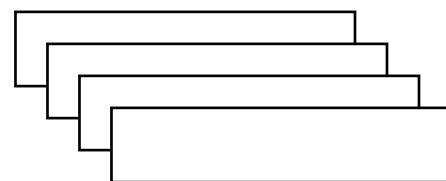
AKA the Red Square

8 Red Floral 2.5" squares

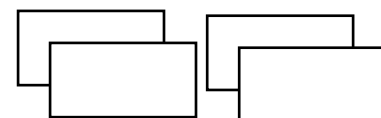


AKA the Red Square

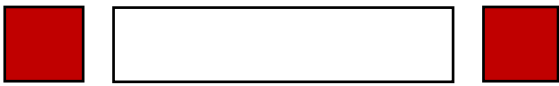

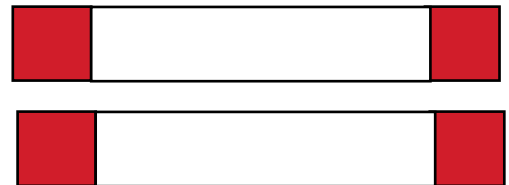
Quilters – Start your Sewing Machine... Let's Sew!!

Step 1. Making the Bars:

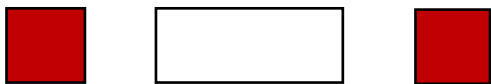
Take one Red square and sew it on both 2.5" sides of the white Large Rectangle. (2.5" x 8.5")



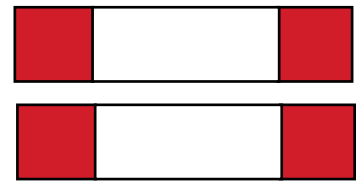
Press Toward the Red.
Repeat with one more Large rectangles.
This will yield two 'Big Bars'
Sewn Measurement is 2.5" x 12.5"



Take one Red square and sew it on both 2.5" sides of the white Small Rectangle. (2.5" x 4.5")



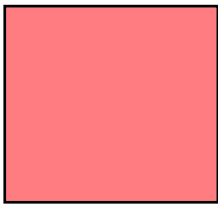
Press Toward the Red.
Repeat with one more small rectangles. This will yield two 'Small bars'



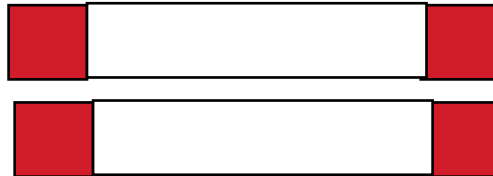
Sewn Measurement is 2.5" x 8.5"

We've got our components but, do a quick inventory before we start!

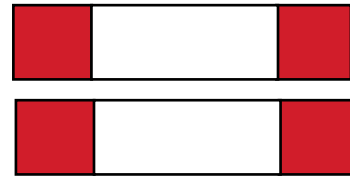
Rose Square



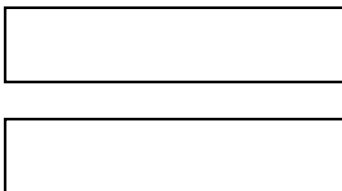
Two Big Bars



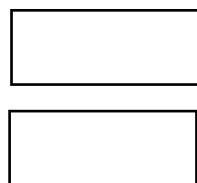
Two Small Bars

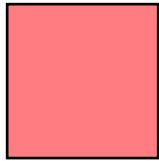

Step 2. Assembly

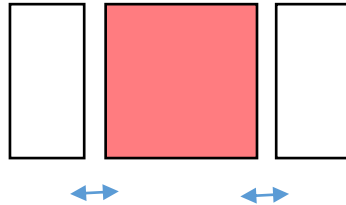
Let's Put this block together:

Construction Step 1.

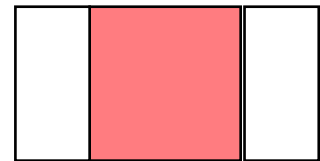
Start with the Rose Square.



Sew a white small rectangle (2.5" x 4.5") on opposite sides of the rose square.

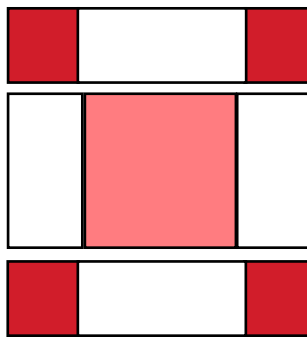


Press toward the rose.
Should measure 4.5" x 8.5"
Tah-Dah ... next step.

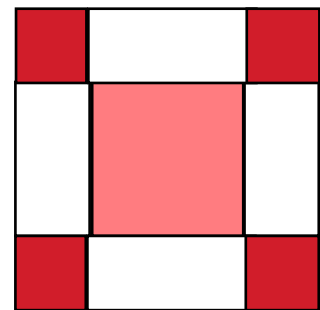


Construction Step 2.

Sew two Small Bars (2.5" x 8.5") to the unit.
Be sure to nest and pin at the seams for accuracy.

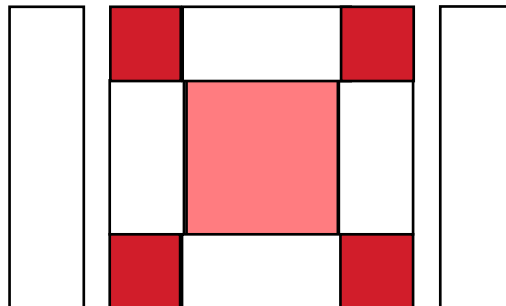


Press and Tah-Dah – This is a great block. But not today.
Should measure 8.5" square.
next step.

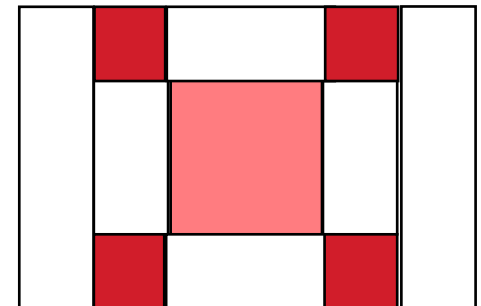


Construction Step 3.

Sew Large Rectangles (2.5" x 8.5") on opposite sides.

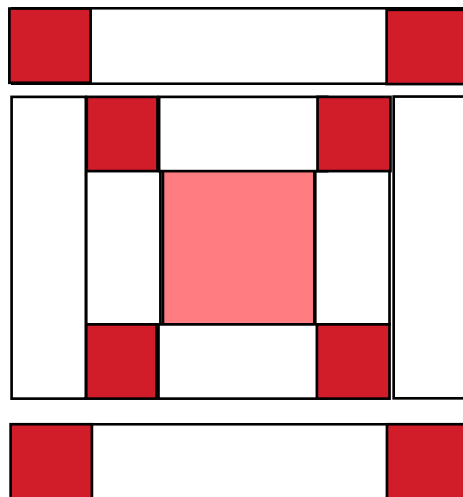


Press. This should measure 8.5" x 12.5"
Almost done...
Next Step.



Construction Step 4.

Sew two Large Bars (2.5" x 12.5") to the unit.
Be sure to nest and pin at the seams for accuracy.



Square up!
Should measure 12.5" square.
