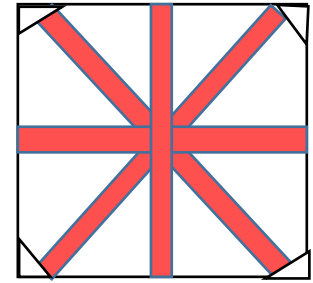
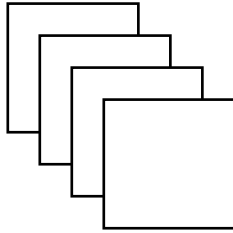

## Snowflake

Charm = 5" Square, Cake = 10" Square, Jelly = 2.5" x WOF

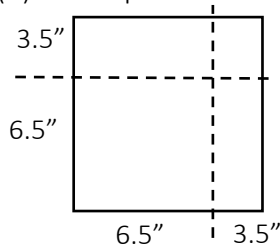
Cutting Directions are written with rotary cutting in mind.  
You will need a 45mm Cutter, Rulers, and Self Healing Mat.

IMAGES NOT TO SCALE – OBVIOUSLY!

The Right Ruler For the Job!  
6.5" x 24.5" Ruler or 6.5" x 12.5"  
and 6.5" Square Ruler!

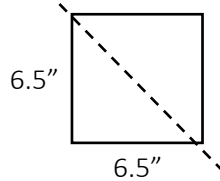
### Cutting Directions:

Press out the crease in the white cakes.  
Stack the 4 White Cakes.  
Cut Four (4) 6.5" Squares  
Cut Four (4) 3.5" Squares

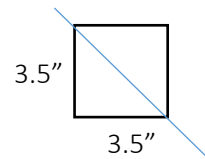


By cutting the 6.5" square you'll cut the 3.5" square.

Cut the 6.5" square in half diagonally. Corner to corner.

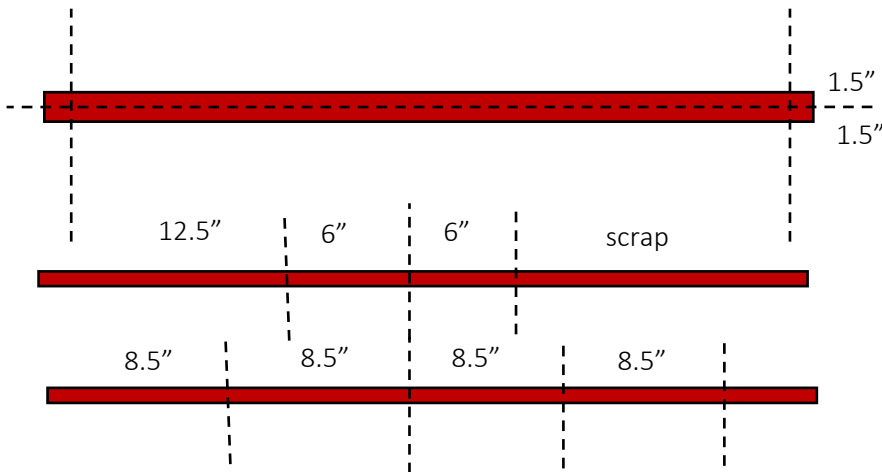


Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of the 3.5" square.



Press out the crease in the Red check Jelly Trim selvages.

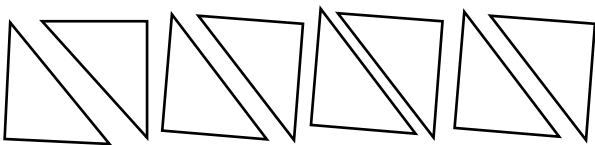
Cut Jelly in half length-wise (hotdog style)  
Or cut two strips 1.25" x WOF



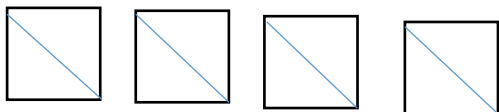
From the two 1.25" x WOF fabric cut the following  
One (1) 1.25" x 12.75"  
Two (2) 1.25" x 6"  
Four (4) 1.25" x 8.5"

### Summary of Cut Pieces:

Eight (8) 6.5" triangles



Four (4) 3.5" squares



Four (4) 1.25" x 8.5"



Two (2) 1.25" x 6"



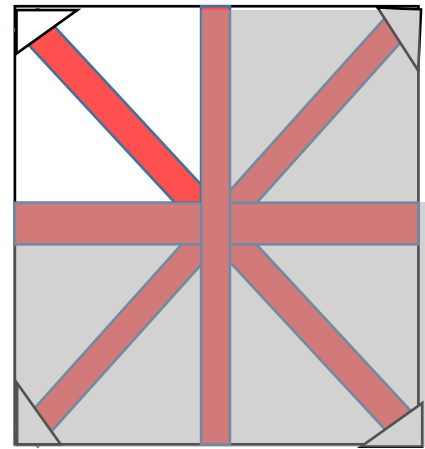
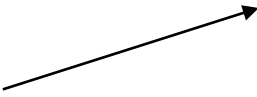
One (1) 1.25" x 12.75"



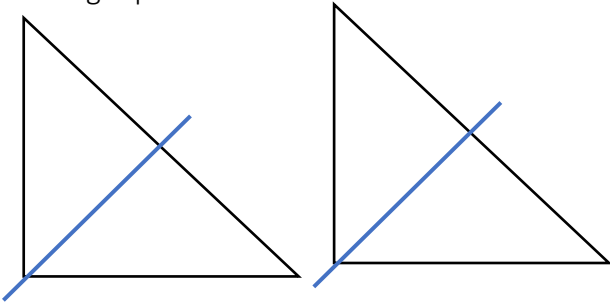
# Sew – Sew -- Sewing Time!!!

## Step 1. Making the Outer Units:

That's the unit that isn't gray'd out.  
We'll make four (4) total of them.

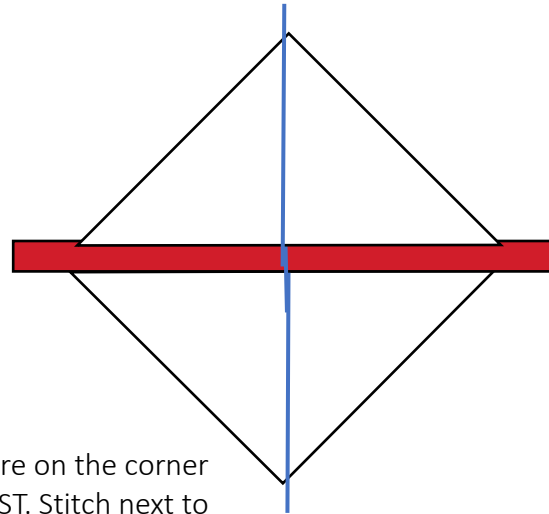
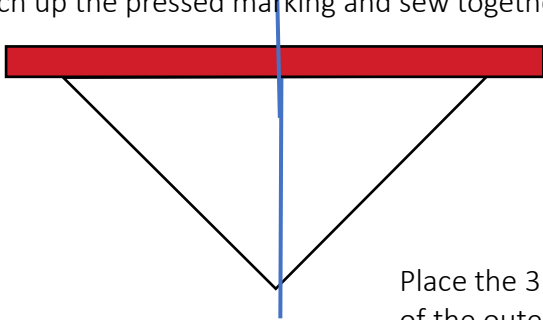


Find the center point on the 8.5" check strip and two (2) 6.5" triangle.  
Finger press.



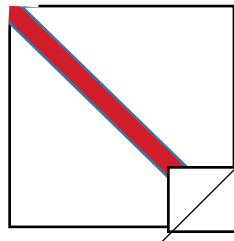
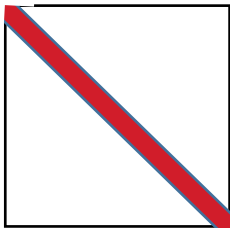
Finger press the center seam on another 6.5" triangle.  
Sew the other side of the marked 1.25" x 8.5" strip.

Match up the pressed marking and sew together.

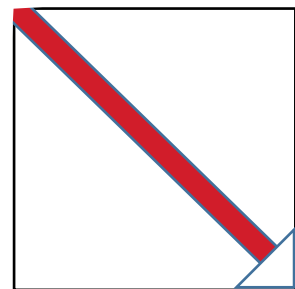
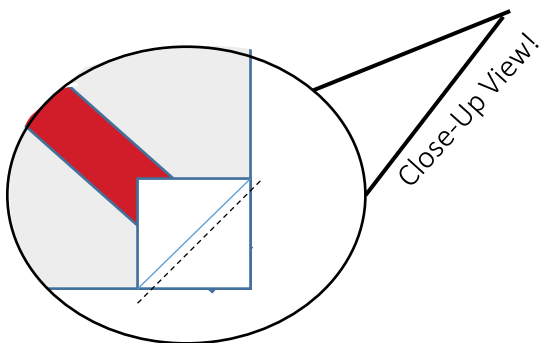


Square up to 6" square

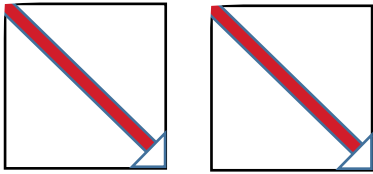
Place the 3.5" square on the corner of the outer unit, RST. Stitch next to the drawn line. See close up view.  
Press toward the corner.



Make 3 more units.  
You'll have 4 units total.



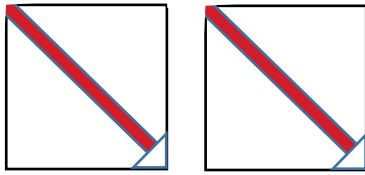
We've got our components but, do a quick inventory before we start!



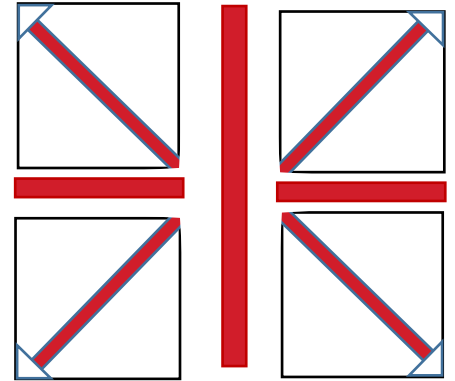
4 Outer Units



Two (2) 1.25" x 6" strips



One (1) 1.25" x 12.75" strips



### Step 3. Assembly -- Let's Put this block together:

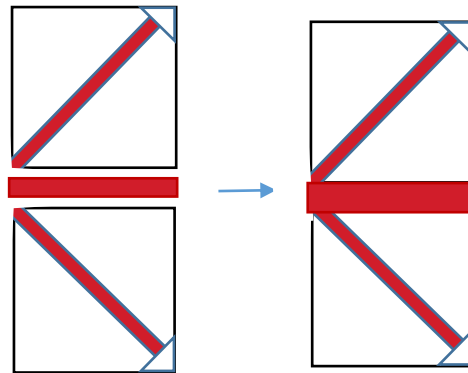
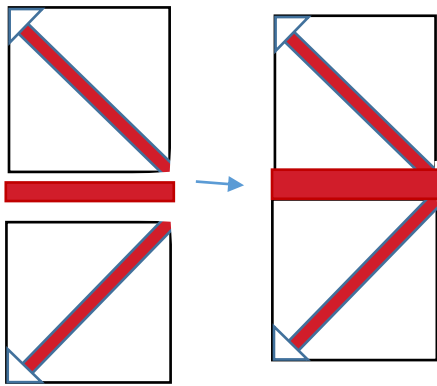
Construction 1:

Layout all the components. See to the side.



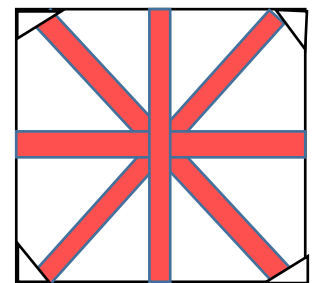
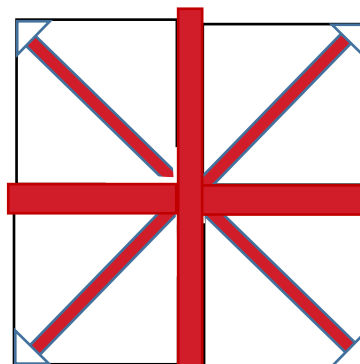
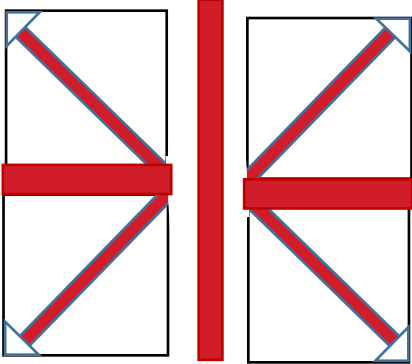
Work outside to inside. Sew the Vertical row together first.



Find center and Sew together.

This will finish over 12.5"  
That's okay.

Square up to 12.5"
