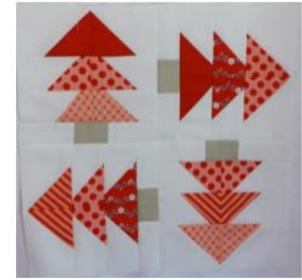

What's in the Kit.

White – 2 Charm, 3 Strip
 Red Woven, Red Floral, Pink Cherries, Red Check,
 and Khaki – 1 charm each
 Rose Floral – 2 charm
 Measure and Press fabric before cutting.



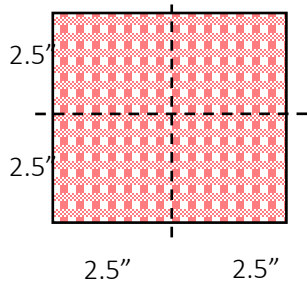
Turning Trees

Charm = 5" Square, Cake = 10" Square, Jelly = 2.5" x WOF

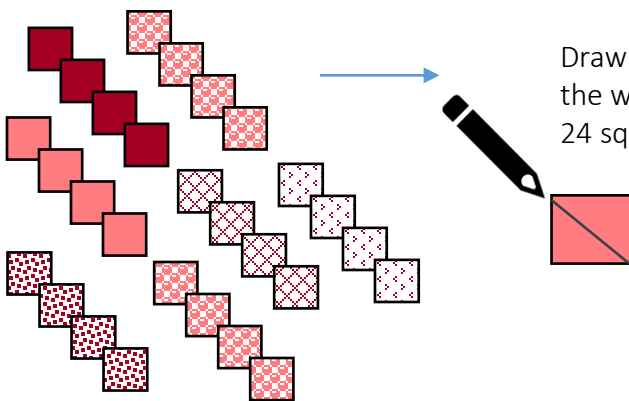
Make sure you have true 5" charms

Cutting Directions:

Stack the Reddish charms
 Red Woven, Red Floral, Pink Cherries, Red
 Check, Rose Floral (both) and cut into 2.5"
 squares.



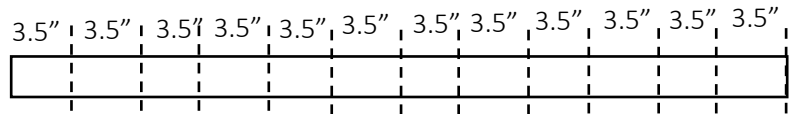
This will yield twenty-four (24) 2.5" squares.



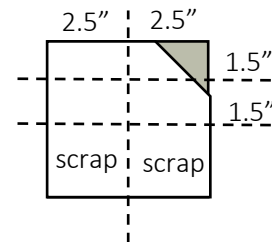
Draw a diagonal line on
 the wrong-side of the
 24 squares.

Trim Salvages!

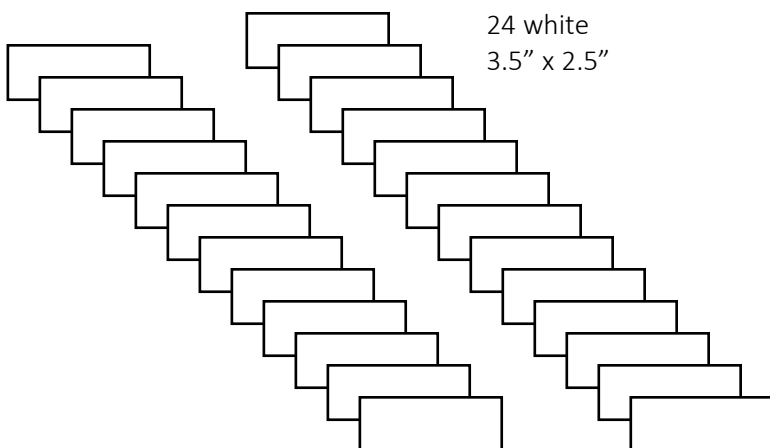
Stack 2 of the 3 strips and cut twenty-four (24) 3.5" rectangles.
 Use the 3rd strip scrap if needed.



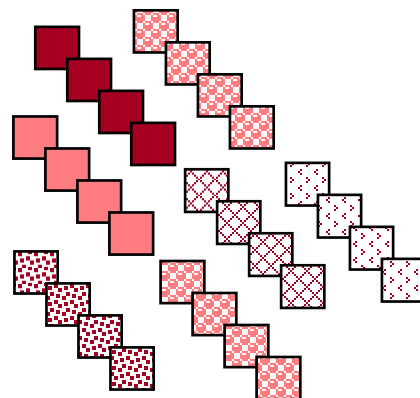
Stack the 2 white charm
 and 1 khaki charm. Cut a
 total of eight (8) 2.5" x
 1.5" white and four (4)
 2.5" x 1.5" white.



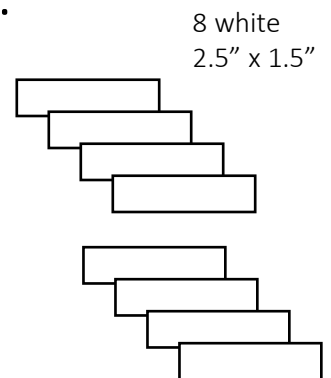
Summary of Cut Pieces:



24 white
 3.5" x 2.5"



24 Misc. Reddish
 2.5" x 2.5" with
 diagonal line
 drawn.



8 white
 2.5" x 1.5"

4 khaki
 2.5" x 1.5"

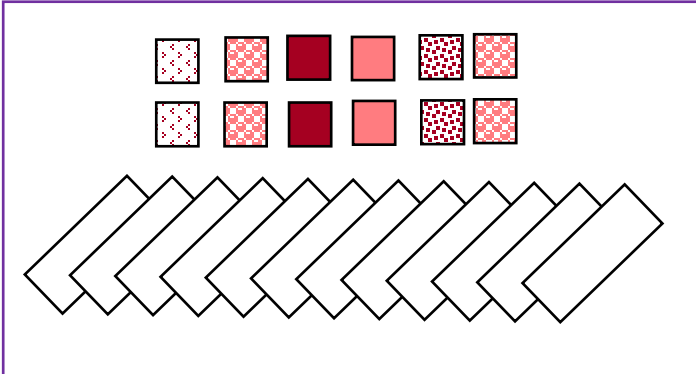
Making the Tree Branches:

Divide Reddish 2.5" squares equally into two piles- A Right Pile and A left Pile.

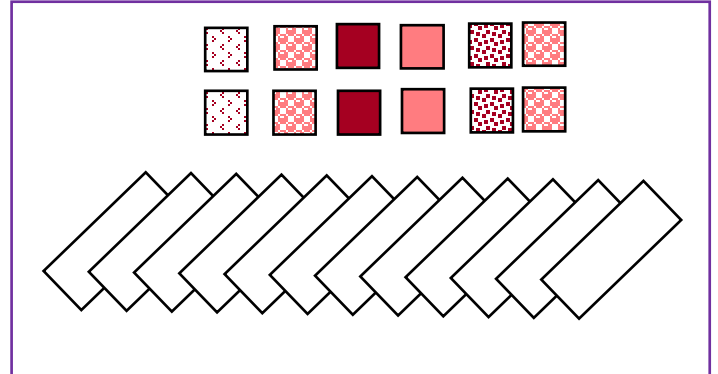
The Name is a indicator of the direction that the square will be sewing on the rectangle. I do know my left from right. ☺

Stack 12 white 3.5" x 2.5" rectangles in pile left and pile right. Piles should match.

Right Pile

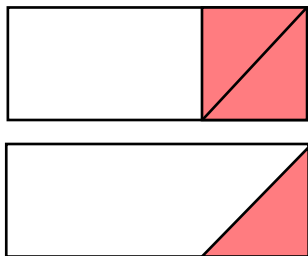


Left Pile

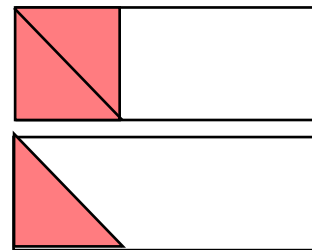


Place one Misc. Reddish 2.5" square RST on the RIGHT side of one 3.5" x 2.5" white rectangle. Sew on drawn line. Flip. Press. Trim away excess. (stitch and flip method.)

Place one Misc. Reddish 2.5" square RST on the LEFT side of 3.5" x 2.5" white rectangle. Sew on drawn line. Flip. Press. Trim away excess. (stitch and flip method.)

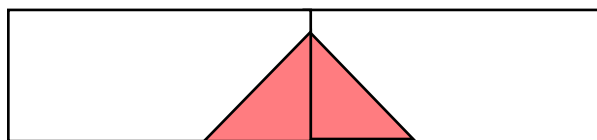


Make 12 Total



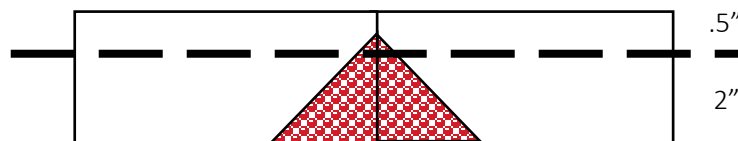
Make 12 Total

Mirror Image



Match up and sew together. Should have 24 Units. Select favorite 4 for top of tree. Set aside.

This will measure 2.5" x 6.5"



Measure from the bottom of the branch. Trim 1/2 inch of the length of the 8 least favorite tree branches. Set aside

This will measure 2" x 6.5"

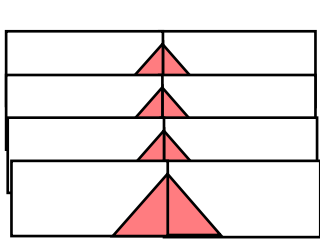
Making the Tree Stump:

Sew one white 2.5" x 1.5" rectangle to both sides of 2.5" x 1.5" khaki rectangle. This will measure 6.5" x 1.5"

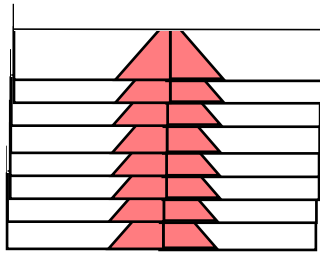
Make 4 Stumps



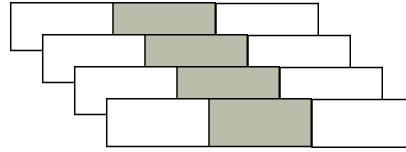
We've got our units but, do a quick inventory before we start!



4 top branches



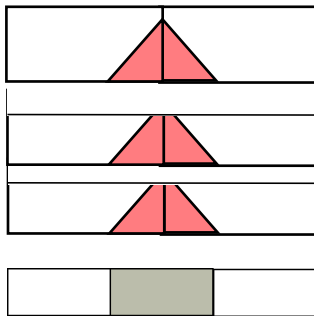
8 lower branches



4 stumps

Assembly -- Let's Put this block together:

Super easy, make a tree! Layout all the components. Sew together the rows. Press. Make 4 trees.

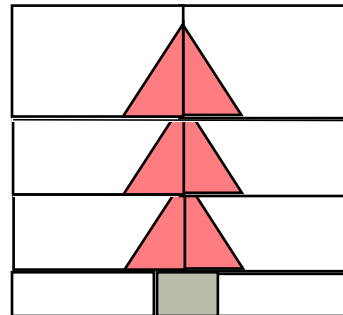


Top branch

Lower branch

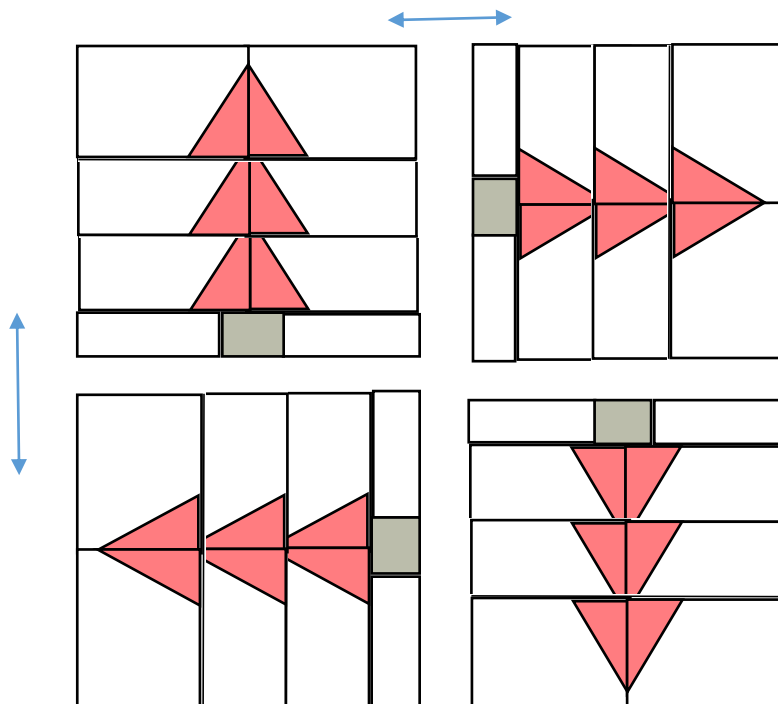
Lower branch

Square up. This should measure 6.5" x 6.5".

Row 6 Simple – It's 13 trees in a row!

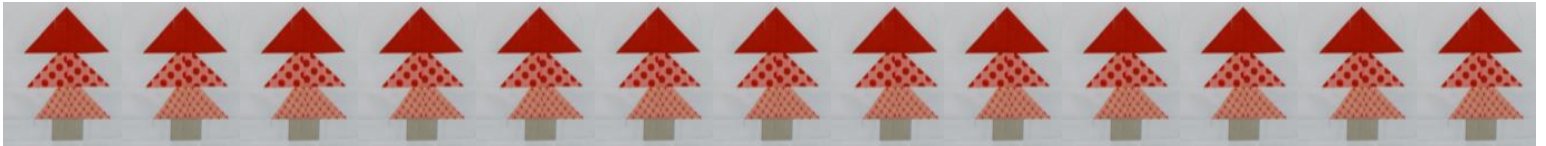
Fabric needed –

26 Strips background fabric.
4 charms for stump.
8 charms for background stump

Following the directions on the block make 13 of the tree blocks and line them up.
