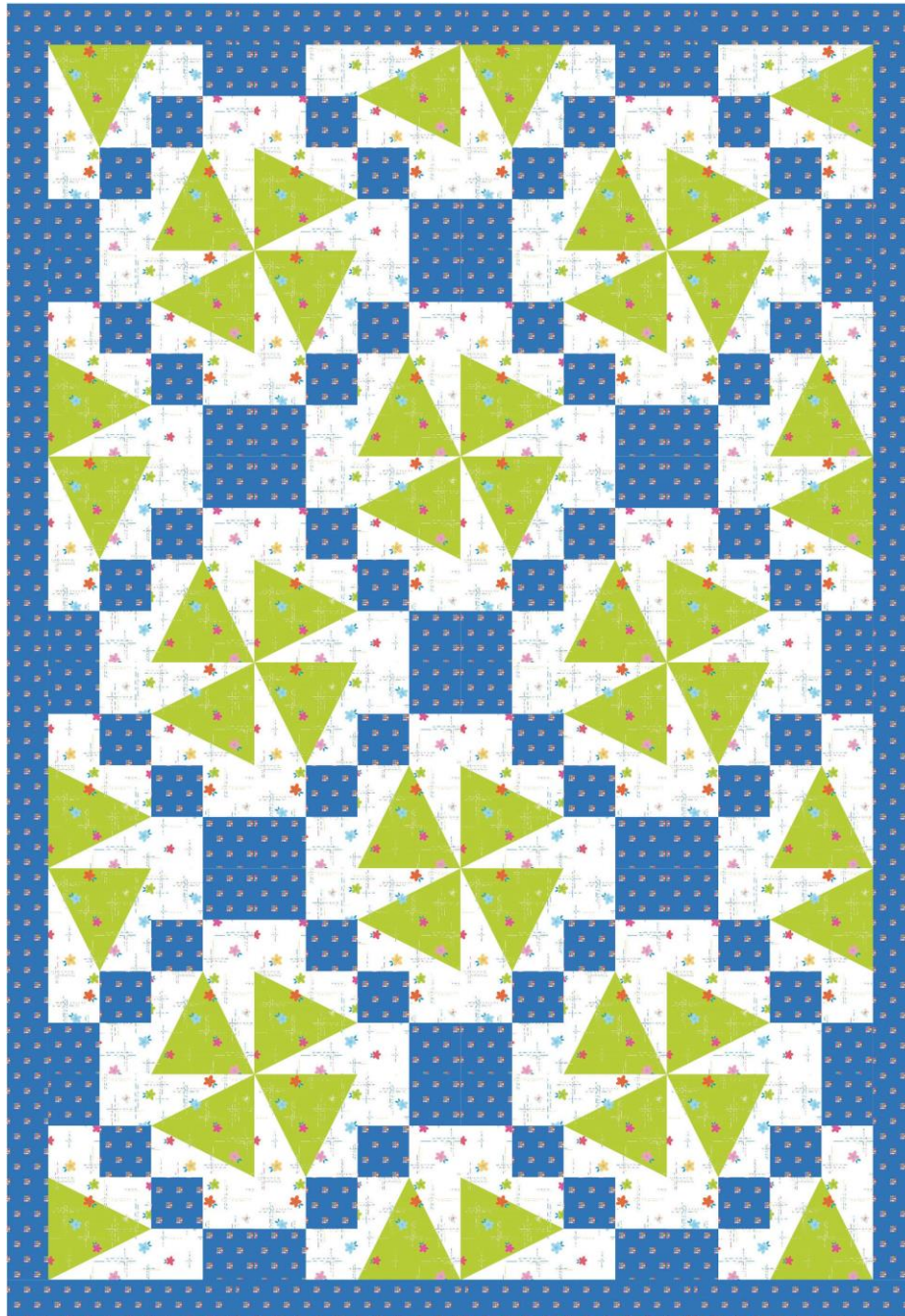


GO! Qube 10" Upbeat Angles Throw Quilt

FINISHED SIZE 44" X 64"



Dies Needed:

GO! Qube Mix & Match Size 10" Block (55797)

- GO! Square-3" (2-1/2" Finished) (Shape 2)

GO! Qube Size 10" Companion Set - Angles (55799)

- GO! Triangles in Square-Center-5" Finished Square (Shape 13)
- GO! Triangles in Square-Sides-5" Finished Square (Shape 14)

Additional Dies Needed

- GO! Strip Cutter 2-1/2" (2" Finished) (55014 or 55017)

Fabric Requirements

Fabric Color	Total Yardage
White Print	2 yards
Blue Print	1-3/4 yards
Green Print	1 yard
Batting	52" x 72"
Backing	52" x 72" (or 3 yards 42" width fabric)

Cutting Directions

Fabric Color	GO! Dies Used	Number of Shapes to Cut
White Print	GO! Square-3" (2-1/2" Finished) (Shape 2)	Cut 9—3-1/2" x width of fabric (WOF) strips. Fanfold into 3-1/2" widths. Sub cut into 96—2-1/2" finished squares.
	GO! Triangles in Square-Sides-5" Finished Square (Shape 14)	Cut 8—4" x WOF strips. Fanfold into 6" widths. Sub cut into 96—5" finished triangle in a square-sides.
Blue Print	GO! Square-3" (2-1/2" Finished) (Shape 2)	Cut 9—3-1/2" x WOF strips. Fanfold into 3-1/2" widths. Sub cut into 96—2-1/2" finished squares.
	GO! Triangles in Square-Center-5" Finished Square (Shape 13)	Cut 5—6" x WOF strips. Layer strips. Use the Cut & Flip™ method. Cut and flip by placing fabric wrong side up and align cut angle of fabric with angle of blades. Continue to cut in this manner by flipping the fabric after each cut across the length of fabric. Sub cut into 48—5" finished Triangle in Square-Centers.
Blue Print for Border and Binding	GO! Strip Cutter-2 1/2" (2" Finished) (55017 or 55014)	Cut 12—2-1/2" x WOF strips. Sub cut 2—2-1/2" x 44-1/2" horizontal borders. Subcut 2—2-1/2" x 60-1/2" vertical borders. Use remaining strips for quilt binding.

Sewing Directions

Press all seams open and use 1/4" seams, unless otherwise indicated.

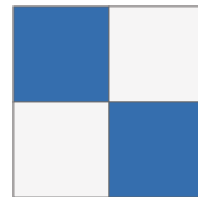
UPBEAT BLOCK

NOTE: Directions will be for one 10" finished block. Make 24 blocks.

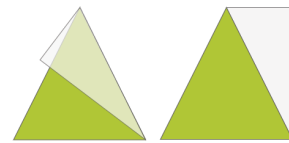
1. Sew one white and one blue 2-1/2" finished square (Shape 2) together as shown. Press seams open. Make 96—2-patch units.



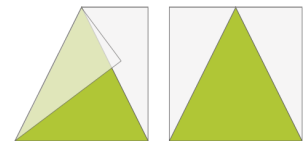
2. Sew two 2-patch units together as shown to make a 4-patch unit. Make 48—4-patch units.



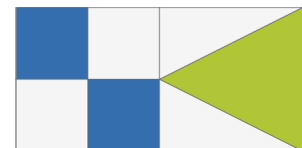
3. Sew a white triangle in a square-side (Shape 14) to a green triangle in a square-center (Shape 13) as shown. Make 48.



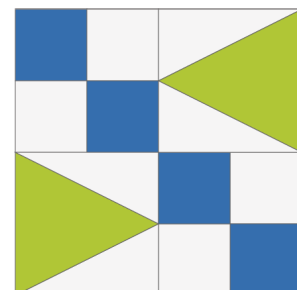
4. Sew the second white triangle in a square-side (Shape 14) to the unit made in Step 3. Make 48 finished triangle in a square units.



5. Sew a 4-patch unit to a triangle in a square unit as shown to make a half block unit. Make 48 half block units.

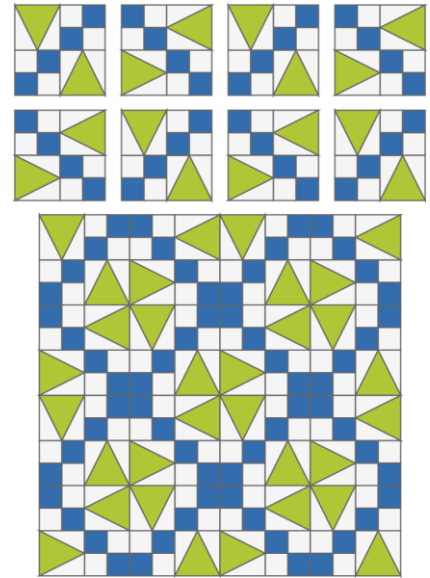


6. Sew two half block units together as shown. Make 24 complete blocks.



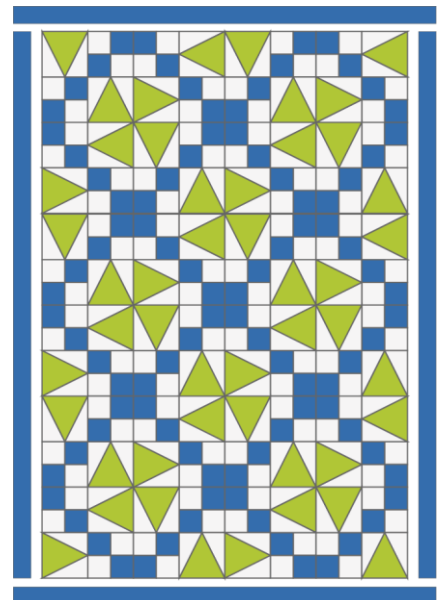
Assemble the Quilt Top

1. Lay out blocks in 6 rows of 4 blocks each as shown in quilt diagram. Sew blocks together into rows. Press seams open.
2. Sew rows together. Press seams open.



Assemble the Borders

1. Cut the vertical and horizontal borders according to the cutting instructions. Measure the height of the quilt and adjust the length of the vertical border accordingly. Stitch the vertical border to the sides of the quilt.
2. Measure the width of the quilt and adjust the length of the horizontal border accordingly. Stitch the horizontal border to the top and bottom of the quilt. Press seam allowances toward the border



Quilting and Finishing:

1. Layer batting between quilt top and backing.
2. Pin or baste layers together.
3. Quilt as desired.
4. Add binding, mitering corners.
