FINISHED MEASUREMENTS

Wingspan: 40"

Depth: 20"

MATERIALS

[Rico Design Creative Cotton](#)

[Camouflage](#) (45% acrylic, 44% cotton, 11% polyamide; 200g/634 yds)

- 002 Rose Garden - 1 ball

Needle: US Size 4 (3.5 mm) 32" or longer circular (to accommodate large number of stitches) *or size needed to obtain gauge*

Notions: Tapestry needle, stitch markers

GAUGE

18 sts x 36 rows = 4" in Garter stitch *after blocking*

Save time, check your gauge.

Knit, Relax, Smile, Repeat!

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PATTERN NOTES

The Garden Tulip Shawl makes the most of one skein of Rico Design Creative Cotton Camouflage for a timeless, versatile accessory. Its lightweight, breathable cotton makes it perfect for any season, while the delicate lace edging adds a touch of understated elegance. Whether draped casually over the shoulders or wrapped snugly around the neck, this shawl is both stylish and practical—a beautiful blend of comfort and charm.

This shawl is knit from the top down starting with a garter tab. Directional increases shape the sides, while a center panel maintains the same number of stitches. The shawl is finished off with a garter and eyelet border with a picot bind off.

This pattern is both written and charted for your convenience.

Picot Bind off

* Cast on 2 sts, bind off 5 sts, 3 Shawl sts bound off; rep from * to last stitch, cast-on 2 sts, bind off 3 sts.

STITCH GUIDE

Blooming Tulip Lace

(panel of 19 sts)

Row 1 (RS): K7, k1 tbl, yo, S2KP2, yo, k1 tbl, k7.

WS Rows 2-36: Purl.

Row 3: K6, k1 tbl, yo, ssk, k1, k2tog, yo, k1 tbl, k6.

Row 5: K5, k1 tbl, yo, ssk, yo, S2KP2, yo, k2tog, yo, k1 tbl, k5.

Row 7: K3, k1 tbl, k1, [yo, ssk] 2 times, k1, [k2tog, yo] 2 times, k1, k1 tbl, k3.

Row 9: K3, yo, S2KP2, yo, k2tog, yo, k1 tbl, k1, k1 tbl, yo, ssk, yo, S2KP2, yo, k3.

Row 11: K3, yo, ssk, [k2tog, yo] 2 times, k1 tbl, [yo, ssk] 2 times, k2tog, yo, k3.

Row 13: K1, k1 tbl, k1, yo, ssk, k1, k2tog, yo, k1 tbl, k1, k1 tbl, yo, ssk, k1, k2tog, yo, k1, k1 tbl, k1.

Row 15: K1, yo, S2KP2, yo, k2tog, k2, k1 tbl, yo, k1, yo, k1 tbl, k2, ssk, yo, S2KP2, yo, k1.

Row 17: K1, yo, ssk, k2tog, yo, k2tog, k1, k1 tbl, yo, k1, yo, k1 tbl, k1, ssk, yo, ssk, k2tog, yo, k1.

Row 19: K1, yo, ssk, k1, k2tog, yo, k2tog, k1 tbl, yo, k1, yo, k1 tbl, ssk, yo, ssk, k1, k2tog, yo, k1.

Row 21: K1, yo, ssk, k2, [k2og, yo] 2 times, k1, [yo, ssk] 2 times, k2, k2tog, yo, k1.

Row 23: K1, yo, ssk, k3, k2tog, yo, k1 tbl, k1, k1 tbl, yo, ssk, k3, k2tog, yo, k1.

Row 25: K2tog, yo, k2tog, k4, k1 tbl, yo, k1, yo, k1 tbl, k4, ssk, yo, ssk.

Row 27: K1, k2tog, yo, k2tog, k3, k1 tbl, yo, k1, yo, k1 tbl, k3, ssk, yo, ssk, k1.

Row 29: K2, k2tog, yo, k2tog, k2, k1 tbl, yo, k1, yo, k1 tbl, k2, ssk, yo, ssk, k2.

Row 31: K3, k2tog, yo, k2tog, k1, k1 tbl, yo, k1, yo, k1 tbl, k1, ssk, yo, ssk, k3.

Row 33: K4, k2tog, yo, k2tog, k1 tbl, yo, k1, yo, k1 tbl, ssk, yo, ssk, k4.

Row 35: K5, [k2tog, yo] 2 times, k1, [yo, ssk] 2 times, k5.

PATTERN BEGINS

SHAWL

Starting Tab

Cast on 3 sts. Knit 42 rows.

Next Row (RS): K3, rotate work 90 degrees clockwise, pick up and knit 21 sts from side of garter tab, pick up and knit 3 sts from cast-on edge - 27 sts.

Next Row (WS): K3, pm, k1, pm, p19, pm, k1, pm, knit to end.

Establish Lace Pattern

Row 1 (RS): Knit to m, sl m, m1R, knit to m, m1L, sl m, work Row 1 of Blooming Tulip Lace to m, sl m, m1R, knit to m, m1L, knit to end - 4 sts inc'd, 31 sts.

Row 2 (WS): Knit to m, sl m, knit to m, sl m, purl to m, sl m, knit to end, slipping m as you come to it.

Cont. in patt as est'd through Row 36 of Blooming Tulip Lace - 68 sts inc'd, 99 sts.

Rep Rows 1-36, 2 more times - 144 sts inc'd, 243 sts.

Border

Row 1 (RS): Knit to m, sl m, m1R, knit to m, m1L, sl m, knit to m, sl m, m1R, knit to m, m1L, sl m, knit to end - 4 sts inc'd, 247 sts.

Row 2 (WS): Knit to end, slipping markers as you come to them.

Rows 3-6: Rep Rows 1-2, 2 times - 8 sts inc'd, 255 sts.

Row 7: Knit to m, sl m, yo, k1 [yo, k2tog] to m, yo, sl m, k1 [yo, k2tog] to m, sl m, yo, [k2tog, yo] to last 1 st bef m, k1, yo, sl m, knit to end - 4 sts inc'd, 259 sts.

Row 8: Rep Row 2.

Rows 9-14: Rep Rows 1-2, 3 times - 12 sts inc'd, 271 sts.

Bind off all sts using the Picot method.

FINISHING

Gently wash and block to finished measurements. Weave in ends.

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Abbreviations

*	indicates a repeat section
cont	continue
est'd	established
inc('d)	increase(d)
k	knit
k2tog	knit 2 stitches together (1 st dec'd)
m	marker
m1L	insert left needle from front to back under horizontal strand of yarn lying between st just worked and next st, knit or purl this st through the back loop (1 st inc'd)
m1R	insert left needle from back to front under horizontal strand of yarn lying between st just worked and next st, knit or purl this st through the front loop (1 st inc'd)
p	purl
pm	place marker
rep	repeat
RS	right side
S2KP2	slip 2 stitches as if to knit 2 together, knit 1, pass 2 slipped stitches over knit stitch; centered double decreases
sl	slip
ssk	slip next 2 sts individually knitwise, slip them back to left needle in this position, knit them together through the back loops (1 st dec'd)
st(s)	stitch(es)
tbl	through the back loop(s)
WS	wrong side
yo	yarn over



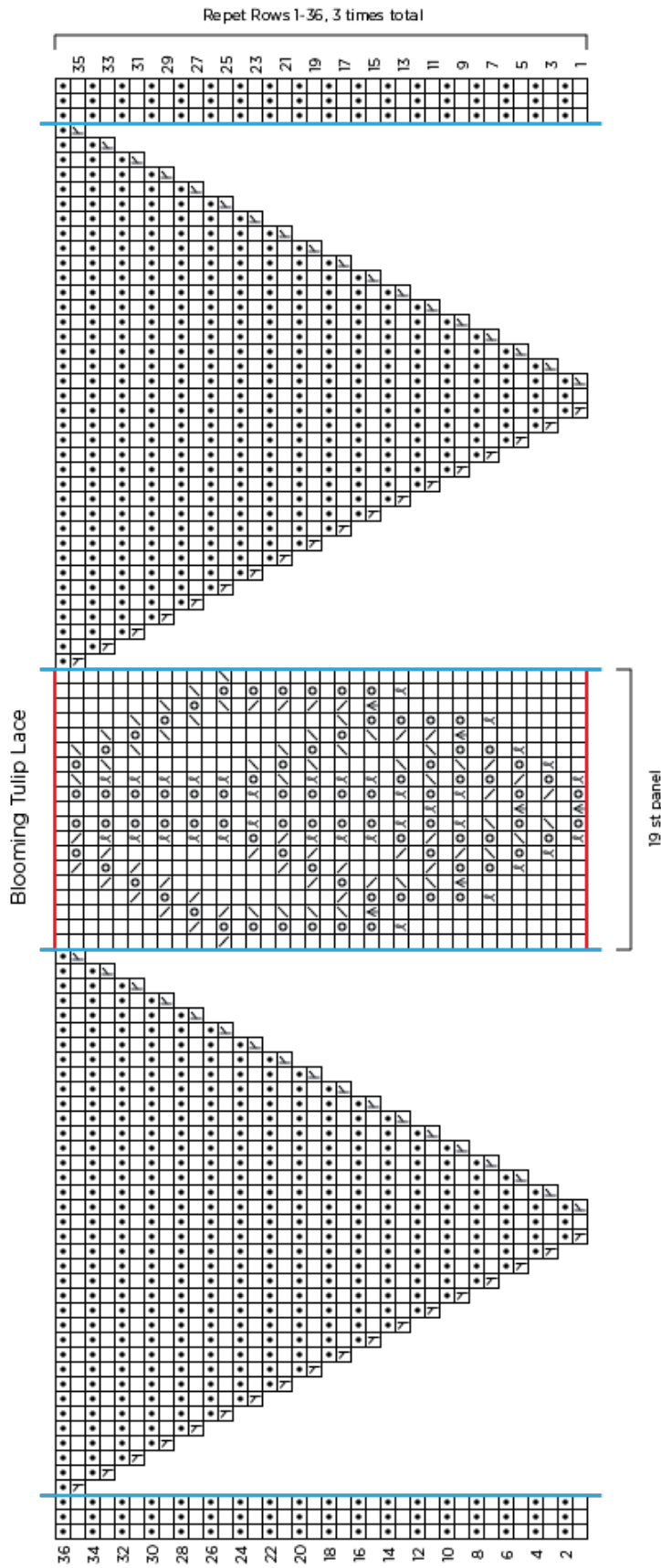
