#### SKILL

Knitting

#### DIFFICULTY

Basic

#### SIZES

One Size

#### FINISHED MEASUREMENTS

**Length:** 41 $\frac{3}{4}$ "

**Width:** 39 $\frac{1}{4}$ "

#### MATERIALS

[Universal Yarn Maman](#) (100% acrylic; 100g/109 yds)

- 512 Sunset - 8 skeins

**Needle:** US Size 9 (5.5 mm) 24" circular or longer (to accommodate large number of sts) *or size needed to obtain gauge*

**Notions:** Tapestry needle, stitch markers

#### GAUGE

12 sts x 19 rows = 4" in Labyrinth patt *after blocking*

**Save time, check your gauge.**

## PATTERN NOTES

Cozy comfort is the name of the game when your little one is wrapped up in their Snuggle Blankie. Just like a warm hug, this adorable textured blanket is delightfully soft and soothing. Our bulky-weight, self-striping Maman yarn brings next-level squish in an array of welcoming hues. Perfect for bedtime, story time, and anytime cuddles.

This blanket is knit flat from the bottom up and features a built-in garter stitch border. The Labyrinth pattern is both written and charted for your convenience.

## STITCH GUIDE

### Labyrinth

(multiple of 18 sts)

**Row 1 (RS):** \* K3, p15; rep from \* to end.

**Row 2 (WS):** \* K15, p3; rep from \* to end.

**Row 3:** Rep Row 1.

**Row 4:** \* K3, p15; rep from \* to end.

**Row 5:** \* K15, p3; rep from \* to end.

**Row 6:** Rep Row 4.

**Row 7:** \* P12, k3, p3; rep from \* to end.

**Row 8:** \* K3, p3, k12; rep from \* to end.

**Row 9:** Rep Row 7.

**Row 10:** \* P6, k3, p9; rep from \* to end.

**Row 11:** \* K9, p3, k6; rep from \* to end.

**Row 12:** Rep Row 10.

**Row 13:** \* P6, k3, p9; rep from \* to end.

**Row 14:** \* K9, p3, k6; rep from \* to end.

**Row 15:** Rep Row 13.

**Row 16:** \* P12, k3, p3; rep from \* to end.

**Row 17:** \* K3, p3, k12; rep from \* to end.

**Row 18:** Rep Row 16.

Rep Rows 1-18 for patt.

## PATTERN BEGINS

### BLANKET

#### Lower Border

Cast on 118 sts.

**Row 1 (RS):** Knit.

**Row 2 (RS):** Knit.

Rep Rows 1-2, 4 more times.

## Main Blanket

*Note 1: A garter stitch border is maintained throughout this section.*

*Note 2: You may choose to place additional stitch markers between the pattern repeats to help you stay on track.*

**Set-up Row 1 (RS):** K5, pm, k3, [p3, k15] 5 times, p3, k12, pm, k5.

**Set-up Row 2 (WS):** Knit to m, sl m, p12, [k3, p15] 5 times, k3, p3, sl m, knit to end.

**Set-up Row 3:** Knit to m, sl m, k3, [p3, k15] 5 times, p3, k12, sl m, knit to end.

**Set-up Row 4:** Rep Set-up Row 2.

**Row 1 (RS):** Knit to m, sl m, work Row 1 of Labyrinth patt to m, sl m, knit to end. Labyrinth patt will be repeated 6 times across each row.

**Row 2 (WS):** Knit to m, sl m, work Row 2 of Labyrinth patt to m, sl m, knit to end.

Cont as est'd through Row 18 of Labyrinth patt.

Then rep Rows 1-18, 8 more times.

Then rep Rows 1-12, one time.

## Upper Border

**Row 1 (RS):** Knit.

**Row 2 (RS):** Knit.

Rep Rows 1-2, 4 more times.

Bind off all sts kwise.

## FINISHING

Gently wash and block to finished measurements. Weave in ends.

## Abbreviations

*	indicates a repeat section
cont	continue
est'd	established
garter st	knit every row
k	knit
kwise	knitwise
m	marker
p	purl
patt	pattern
pm	place marker
rep	repeat
RS	right side
sl	slip
st(s)	stitch(es)
WS	wrong side

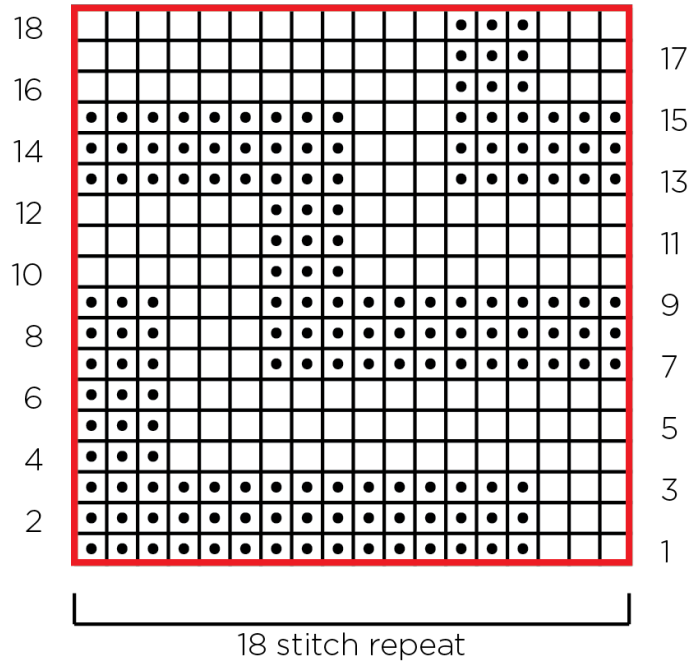
