EXPERIENCE LEVEL

- Beginner

MATERIALS

- Metalico (50% Baby Alpaca, 50% Silk; 50g/147yds): 1 hank
- Size 5 (3.75mm) double pointed needles, or size needed to obtain gauge
- Embellish Knit Automatic Spool Loom (optional, in place of double pointed needles)
- Tapestry needle

SIZE

- One

FINISHED MEASUREMENTS

- Length: 348"

GAUGE

- 1 st = ¼"
- 24 rnds = 4"

NOTES: Exact gauge is not critical for this project, but will affect finished size and drape.

ABBREVIATIONS

BO:	bind off
CO:	cast on
dpns:	double pointed needles
k:	knit
LH:	left hand
meas:	measures
ndl:	needle
rep:	repeat
RH:	right hand
rnd(s):	round(s)
sl:	slip
st(s):	stitch(es)

STITCH PATTERNS

4-STITCH I-CORD

CO 4 sts.

ROW 1: k4; do not turn; sl 4 sts from RH ndl to LH ndl.

Rep row 1 until I-cord is desired length.

OR

Follow the directions for the Embellish Knit Automatic Spool Loom.

NOTES: This project can be worked using dpns or the Embellish Knit Automatic Spool Loom.

NECKLACE

With two dpns or the Embellish Knit Automatic Spool Loom, work 4-Stitch I-cord until piece meas 348" or desired length.

BO.

FINISHING

Block to remove twists.

Sew CO edge to BO edge. Weave in ends.

Style as desired using loops and knots.

CARE INSTRUCTIONS: Hand wash or dry clean. Wash in tepid water using a mild soap. Do not twist. Shape and dry flat on a towel.
