

Scrubby Pattern

Materials:

1 ball of Creative Bubble (makes approximately 3 scrubbies)

Size 2.5 mm knitting needles

Size 3.5 mm crochet hook

Abbreviations:

K: knit

P: Purl

Sl1pwyif: Slip stitch as if to purl, while holding yarn at the front of work

Sl1pyib: slip stitch as if to purl, while holding yarn at the back of work

tbl: knit stitch through the back



Cast on 23 stitches leaving about a 15" tail to use to sew the scrubby together

Row 1: sl1pwyif, *K1tbl, P1*, repeat to end of row (right side)

Row 2: sl1pwyib, *K to end of row

Repeat these two rows until piece measures 8 inches long, ending with a Row 2.

Cast off, leaving the last stitch on the needle. Do not cut yarn.

Fold bottom edge to top edge with wrong sides together, having cast off edge facing you.

Take last stitch off the knitting needle and insert crochet hook into this stitch. Push crochet hook through the top left corner of the cast on edge. (Straight behind the last stitch) Hook yarn and pull it through the back corner and through the stitch on the hook.

Chain 10. Insert hook through both layers at the top left corner. Pull yarn through and end off. Leave a long tail for sewing the sides together.

Using a whip stitch, sew both sides and the top together. Tuck in ends.
