the halton spa cloth trio

A relaxing trio of "spa cloths" to knit & enjoy. If you can cast on, knit, and bind off, you can make a Garter Stitch spa cloth. If you can purl, you can make all three! Just one skein of luxurious Cascade Ultra Pima Cotton + one pair of 4 mm (US 6) knitting needles yields three ~ 6.75" (17 cm) square spa cloths.







GARTER STITCH

Cast on 36 stitches.

Row 1: Knit to end of row.

Repeat this row until your cloth is as long as it is wide (ie. a square).

GARTER + SLIP STITCH

Cast on 41 stitches.

Row 1: *K6, slip 1 stitch purlwise; repeat from * to last 6 stitches, K6.

Row 2: *K6, P1; repeat from * to last 6 stitches, K6.

Repeat these 2 rows until your cloth is as long as it is wide end after working a Row 1.

SEED STITCH

Cast on 35 stitches.

Row 1: *K1, P1; repeat from * to last stitch, K1.

Repeat this row until your cloth is as long as it is wide.

GETTING	STARTED: Use any cast-on method you like. Personally, I like the long tail cast-on method; it's tidy & flexible.
PRO TIP (o	ptional): Slip the first stitch of every row <i>knit-wise</i> to create neater edges.
FINISHING	Bind off knit-wise. Cut your working yarn-leaving a 6" (15 cm) tail-and weave in loose ends on wrong side.
ABBREVIA	TIONS
K: Knit	P: Purl
Knit-wise: a	s if you were going to knit the stitch—ie. enter the stitch from front to back.
Purl-wise: a	s if you were going to purl the stitch—ie. enter the stitch from back to front.

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
