

Cutting Instructions:

Please read all instructions carefully before beginning. Strips are cut across the width of fabric **WOF** (perpendicular to selvedges) unless otherwise stated. All seams are sewn with 1/4" seam unless otherwise stated. Label all pieces.

Fabric A:

• Fussy cut one 22 1/2" x 41 1/2" rectangle centered on the panel. (Quilt Center)

Fabric B:

• Cut one 3 1/2" x WOF strip; sub-cut five 3 1/2" x 4 1/2" rectangles. (Blocks)

Fabric C:

• Cut three 5 1/2" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end and cut two 5 1/2" x 49 1/2" strips. (Outer Border)

Fabric D:

• Cut one 3 1/2" x WOF strip; sub-cut five 3 1/2" x 4 1/2" rectangles. (Blocks)

Fabric E:

• Cut three 1 1/2" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut two 1 1/2" x 45 1/2" strips. **(Sashing)**

Fabric F:

 Cut twelve 1 1/2" x WOF strips; sub-cut ten 1 1/2" x 5 1/2" rectangles and forty 1 1/2" x 9 1/2" rectangles. (Blocks)

Fabric G:

- Cut one 9 1/2" x WOF strip; sub-cut twenty 1 1/2" x 9 1/2" rectangles. (Blocks)
- Cut two 2 1/2" x 22 1/2" WOF strips. (Quilt Center)

- Cut three 2 1/2" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut two 2 1/2" x 45 1/2" strips. (Quilt Center)
- Cut three 1 1/2" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut two 1 1/2" x 45 1/2" strips. (Sashing)
- Cut five 2 1/2" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut two 2 1/2" x 48 1/2" strips and two 2 1/2" x 49 1/2" strips. (Borders)

Fabric H:

- Cut one 5 1/2" x WOF strip; sub-cut twenty 1 1/2" x 5 1/2" rectangles. (Blocks)
- Cut one 9 1/2" x WOF strip; sub-cut twenty 1 1/2" x 9 1/2" rectangles. (Blocks)


Binding:

• Cut six 2 1/4" x WOF strips.


Piecing Instructions:

Note: Pay attention to the unit orientations while assembling the various components.


 Sew one 2 1/2" x 22 1/2" Fabric G strip to each side of the 22 1/2" x 41 1/2" Fabric A rectangle. Sew one 2 1/2" x 45 1/2" Fabric G strip to the top and bottom of the Fabric A rectangle to make the 45 1/2" x 26 1/2" Center Block. (Diagram 1)




 Sew one 1 1/2" x 5 1/2" Fabric H rectangle to the top and bottom of one 1 1/2" x 5 1/2" Fabric F rectangle lengthwise to make one 5 1/2" x 3 1/2" Unit 1 rectangle. (Diagram 2) Repeat to make ten Unit 1 rectangles total.



- Sew one 3 1/2" x 4 1/2" Fabric B rectangle to the left side of one Unit 1 rectangle to make one 9 1/2" x 3 1/2" Unit 2 rectangle. (Diagram 3) Repeat to make five Unit 2 rectangles total.
- Sew one 3 1/2" x 4 1/2" Fabric D rectangle to the left side of one Unit 1 rectangle to make one 9 1/2" x 3 1/2" Unit 3 rectangle. (Diagram 4) Repeat to make five Unit 3 rectangles total.




5. Sew together three 1 1/2" x 9 1/2" **Fabric F** rectangles and two 1 1/2" x 9 1/2" **Fabric H** rectangles, lengthwise and alternating them from top to bottom, to make one 9 1/2" x 5 1/2" Unit 4 rectangle. (Diagram 5) Repeat to make ten Unit 4 rectangles total.




Make (10) = 9 1/2" x 5 1/2" unfinished Diagram 5

 Sew together one 1 1/2" x 9 1/2" Fabric F, one Unit 2 rectangle and one Unit 4 rectangle, lengthwise and in that order from top to bottom, to make one 9 1/2" Block One square. (Diagram 6) Repeat to make three Block One squares total.




Make (3) = 9 1/2" x 9 1/2" unfinished Diagram 6

7. Repeat Step 6 and refer to Diagrams 7-9 for fabric/unit identification, placement and orientation to make three Block Two squares, two Block Three squares and two Block Four squares.




Make (3) = 9 1/2" x 9 1/2" unfinished Diagram 7

Make (2) = 9 1/2" x 9 1/2" unfinished Diagram 8




Make (2) = 9 1/2" x 9 1/2" unfinished Diagram 9

8. Sew together three Block One squares and two Block Three squares, alternating them from left to right, to make the 45 1/2" x 9 1/2" Inner Top Border. (Diagram 10).



9. Sew together three Block Two squares and two Block Four squares, alternating them from left to right, to make the 45 1/2" x 9 1/2" Inner Bottom Border. (Diagram 11).




Quilt Assembly:

- 10. Sew one 1 1/2" x 45 1/2" **Fabric E** strip to the top and bottom of the Quilt Center.
- 11. Sew one 1 1/2" x 45 1/2" **Fabric G** strip to the top and bottom of the Quilt Center.
- 12. Sew the Inner Top Border and Inner Bottom Border to the top and to the bottom of the Quilt Center.
- Sew one 2 1/2" x 48 1/2" Fabric G strip to each side of the Quilt Center. Sew one 2 1/2" x 49 1/2" Fabric G strip to the top and bottom of the Quilt Center.
- 14. Sew one 5 1/2" x 49 1/2" **Fabric C** strip to the top and bottom of the Quilt Center to make the quilt top.

Finishing:

- 15. Prepare backing using two widths of fabric with a horizontal seam. Press seams open. Trim to 57" x 70".
- 16. Layer the quilt, batting and backing. Baste layers together.
- 17. Quilt as desired.
- 18. Trim layers even with quilt top, squaring corners.
- 19. Attach 2 1/4" binding strips using your favorite method.
