

Т		54788-3 Blue	1-1/4	 (1) 5-7/8" x WOF strip; subcut (2) 5-7/8", (2) 3-1/2" and (1) 3" squares. Cut 5-7/8" squares diagonally in half to make (4) large triangles. Outer Border: (7) 4-1/2" x WOF strips, sew short ends together. Subcut (2) 4-1/2" x 66" strips and (2) 4-1/2" x 61-1/2" strips.

BLOCK ASSEMBLY

1. Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of (2) **V** 3-1/2" white squares. Pair a marked square right sides together with (1) 3-1/2" **A** square. Stitch 1/4" on both sides of the drawn line, cut on the line, and press open. Square up to measure 3" square. Make a total of (4) **A-V** HST units.








A-V HST unit Make (4)

2. Sew the short sides of (2) small **V** triangles to the **A** side of (1) **A-V** HST unit. Sew to (1) large **A** triangle along long edges to make a block corner unit measuring 5-1/2" square. Make (4).









Block corner unit Make (4)



3. Lay out (4) block corner units, (4) **V** 3" \times 5-1/2" rectangles and (1) 3" **A** square into (3) rows of (3). Sew into rows and join the rows to make (1) **A** block measuring 13" square.

4. Repeat steps 1-3 to make (1) block each using prints **B-T** for a total of (20) blocks.

QUILT ASSEMBLY

- **5.** Lay out the blocks into (5) rows of (4) blocks each. Sew the blocks into rows and join the rows to complete the quilt center.
- **6.** Inner Border: Sew (2) **U** 2" x 63" strips to the left and right sides of quilt center, followed by (2) **U** 2" x 53-1/2" strips to the top and bottom.
- **7.** Outer Border: Sew (2) **T** 4-1/2" x 66" strips to the left and right sides of quilt, followed by (2) **T** 4-1/2" x 61-1/2" strips to the top and bottom to complete the quilt top.

FINISHING: Layer quilt top, batting and backing together to form quilt sandwich. Baste and quilt as desired. Bind using **U** 2-1/4" strips.
