Approximate size: 52 1/4" x 61 1/4"

*Featuring fabrics from the Little Darlings Halloween fabric collection

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Finished size approximately: 52 1/4" x 61 1/4"

Yardage:

Fabric A	LDHA-6180-PA.....	1 panel
Fabric B	LDHA-6182-MU.....	3 1/2 yards
Fabric C	LDHA-6188-KMU.....	7/8 yard*
Backing	3 1/2 yards
Batting	61" x 70"

* Includes binding

Cutting Instructions:

Please read all instructions carefully before beginning. Strips are cut across the width of fabric **WOF** (perpendicular to selvages) unless otherwise stated. All seams are sewn with 1/4" seam unless otherwise stated. Label all pieces.

Fabric A:

- Fussy cut one 21 3/4" x 30 3/4" rectangle centered on the motif. (**Quilt Center**)

Fabric B:

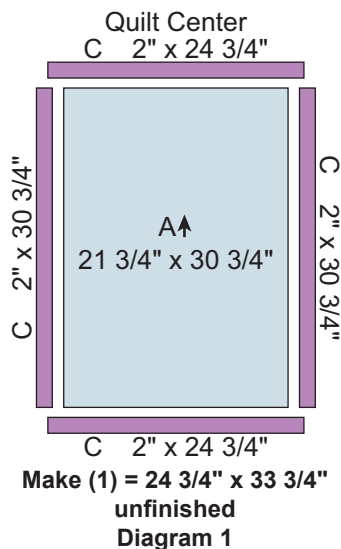
- Cut two 14 1/2" x 57" Length of Fabric (LOF) strips. (**Outer Border**)
- Cut two 14 1/2" x 66" LOF strips. (**Outer Border**)

Fabric C:

- Cut four 2" x WOF strips; sub-cut two 2" x 24 3/4" strips and two 2" x 30 3/4" strips. (**Inner Border**)
- Cut eight 2 1/4" x WOF strips, or enough to make 238" of bias binding. (**Binding**)

Piecing Instructions:

- Sew one 2" x 30 3/4" **Fabric C** strip to each side of the 21 3/4" x 30 3/4" **Fabric A** rectangle. Sew one 2" x 24 3/4" **Fabric C** strip to the top and bottom of the **Fabric A** rectangle to make the 24 3/4" x 33 3/4" Quilt Center. (Diagram 1)



Quilt Assembly:

- Center one 14 1/2" x 66" **Fabric B** strip on one side of the Quilt Center and pin in place. Start sewing the strip a 1/4" from the top edge of the block and stop a 1/4" from the bottom edge. **DO NOT TRIM THE EXCESS.** Repeat with the opposite side.
- Repeat Step 2 to sew one 14 1/2" x 57" **Fabric B** strip to the top and to the bottom of the Quilt Center, making sure to stop and start 1/4" away from each end of the block. To miter each corner, fold the Quilt Center on a diagonal, wrong side together. This should line up the strips from adjacent sides. (Diagram 2)
- Starting at the sewn seam (represented by the arrow in Diagram 2), draw a 45-degree line to the edge of the fabric. Sew on the drawn line. Trim the excess fabric leaving a 1/4" seam. Repeat this step with the remaining corners to make the Quilt Top.

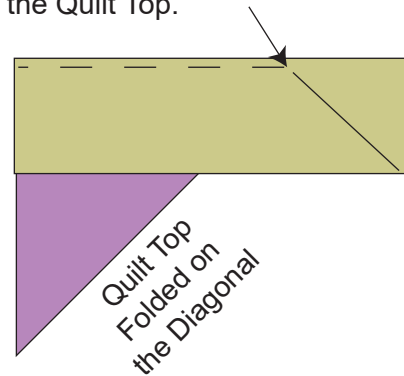
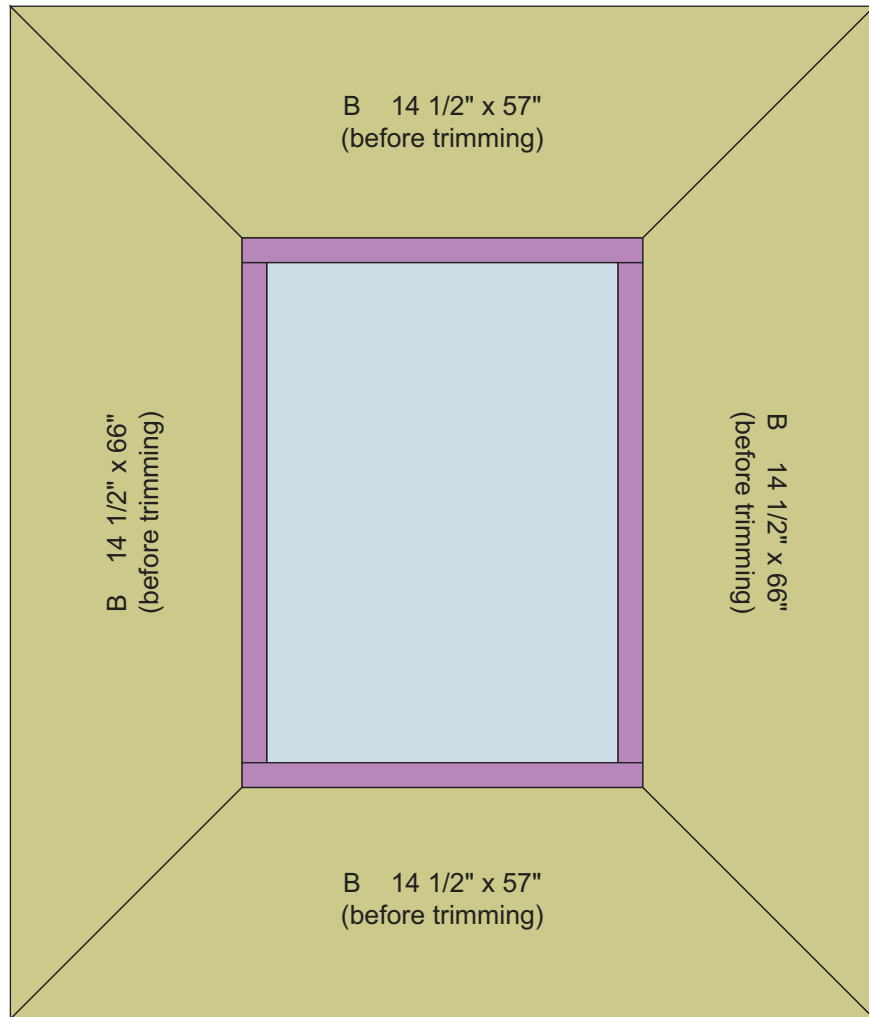

Finishing:

- Prepare backing using two widths of fabric with a vertical seam. Press seams open. Trim to 61" x 70".
- Layer the quilt, batting and backing. Baste layers together.
- Quilt as desired.
- Trim layers even with quilt top, squaring corners.
- Attach 2 1/4" **Fabric C** binding strips using your favorite bias binding method.

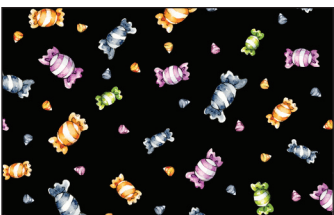

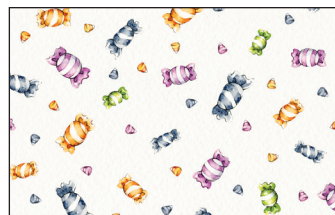
