

E		54683-2 Day INCLUDES BINDING	7/8	Inner Border 1: (4) 1-1/2" x WOF strips; subcut (2) 1-1/2" x 40-1/2" and (2) 1-1/2" x 34-1/2" strips. Note: Piece WOF strips from leftovers to size if WOF strips are not sufficient to cut 40-1/2" length.  Binding: (8) 2-1/4" x WOF strips.
		Backing	4-1/2	71" x 80" piece of batting.

#### **INNER BORDER 3**

#### LARGE STAR BLOCK

1. Flying Geese Unit: Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of (1) **D** 2-3/4" square. Place square, right sides together, at a corner of (1) **B** 2-3/4" x 5" rectangle. Sew on drawn line. Trim 1/4" away from sewn line. Open and press to reveal **D** corner triangle. Repeat with another **D** square on the opposite corner of the same **B** rectangle. Make (4).



Repeat on opposite corner.

2. Rows 1 & 3: Sew (2) B 2-3/4" squares to the opposite short sides of (1) Flying Geese Unit from Step 1. Make (2).





#### NOTE ROTATION OF UNITS.

3. Row 2: Sew (2) Flying Geese Units to the opposite sides of (1) **D** 5" square. Make (1).

**4.** Large Star Block: Sew Rows 1 & 3 units to the opposite long sides of Row 2 unit to complete block, as shown, measuring 9-1/2" square unfinished. Make (2).





#### MEDIUM STAR BLOCK

- 5. Flying Geese Unit: Repeat Step 1 using (8) D 2" squares and (4) B 2" x 3-1/2" rectangles. Make (4).
- 6. Row 1 & 3: Repeat Step 2 using (4) **B** 2" squares and (2) Flying Geese Units. Make (2).
- 7. Row 2: Repeat Step 3 using (1) D 3-1/2" square and (2) Flying Geese Units. Make (1).
- 8. Sew together Rows 1-3, similar to Step 4. Block measures 6-1/2" square unfinished. Make (1).
- 9. Medium Star Block: Sew (2) B 2" x 6-1/2" rectangles to the left/right sides of Step 8 unit, followed by (2) B 2" x 9-1/2" rectangles to the top/bottom sides of unit to complete block. Block measures 9-1/2" square unfinished. Make (5).

#### **SMALL STAR BLOCK**

- 10. Flying Geese Unit: Repeat Step 1 using (8) D1-1/2" squares and (4) B 1-1/2" x 2-1/2" rectangles.Make (4).
- Row 1 & 3: Repeat Step 2 using (4) B 1-1/2" squares and (2) Flying Geese Units. Make (2).
- **12.** Row 2: Repeat Step 3 using (1) **D** 2-1/2" square and (2) Flying Geese Units. Make (1).
- **13.** Sew together Rows 1-3, similar to Step 4. Block measures 4-1/2" square unfinished. Make (1).
- **14.** Small Star Block: Sew (2) **B** 3" x 4-1/2" rectangles to the left and right sides of Step 8 unit, followed by (2) **B** 3" x 9-1/2" rectangles to the top and bottom sides of unit to complete block. Block measures 9-1/2" square unfinished. Make (8).



Make (8) Measures 9-1/2" square unfinished.

#### **BORDERS**

Note: Border Strips are sewn to the left and right sides of quilt center first, followed by the top and bottom of quilt center second.

- **15.** Inner Border 1: (2) **E** 1-1/4" x 40-1/2", then (2) **E** 1-1/4" x 34-1/2".
- **16.** Inner Border 2: (2) **D** 1-1/2" x 42", then (2) **D** 2-1/4" x 36-1/2".

#### INNER BORDER 3

- 17. a. Sew together (3) Small and (1) Medium Star Blocks and (1) B 9-1/2" square to make a pieced column. Make (2) columns and sew to the left and right sides of quilt center.
  - b. Sew together (1) **B** 9-1/2" x 18-1/2" rectangle, (1) **Small**, (2) **Medium** and (1) **Large Star Blocks** to make a pieced row. Sew to the top of quilt center.
  - c. Sew together (1) **B** 9-1/2" x 27-1/2" rectangle, (1) **Small**, (1) **Medium** and (1) **Large Star Blocks** to make a pieced row. Sew to the bottom of quilt center.
- **18.** Inner Border **4**: (2) **D** 1-1/2" x 63-1/2", then (2) **D** 1-1/2" x 56-1/2".
- **19.** Outer Border: (2) **C** 4" x 65-1/2", then (2) **C** 4" x 63-1/2" to complete quilt top.



#### **QUILT DIAGRAM**



**FINISHING:** Layer quilt top, batting and backing together to form quilt sandwich. Baste and quilt as desired. Bind using **E** 2-1/4" strips.
