# Baltimore Blocks for Beginners with Mimi Dietrich

### Description

Learn the basics of appliqueing as you stitch your first Baltimore-style block with Mimi Dietrich. This class includes step-by-step instructions for stitching stems, leaves, circles, dimensional folded buds, birds, and a Baltimore rose. Mimi will provide a full-size pattern to make a 29" square wall hanging.

#### Fabric

- I yard of multicolored inspiration print for setting triangles, outer border, and binding
- Several fat quarters\* or ¼ yard pieces of assorted prints for applique pieces
  - o Stems
  - o Leaves
  - o Berries
  - o Buds
  - o Bird
  - o Flower
- 1 fat quarter\* or ½ yard of fabric for applique background (need to cut a 15" square)
- ¼ yard (not a fat guarter) of accent fabric for inner border
- 1 yard of fabric for backing
- 1 yard of batting

## Class Supplies

- · Thread to match fabrics
- Thimble
- Paper scissors
- Small sharp scissors that cut to the point
- Straight pins (Clover applique pins recommended)
- Sharp pencil

- Your favorite applique needles
- Fabric marker that will show on background fabric
- Freezer paper
- Scotch Removable Magic Tape
- Glue Stick
- Small Tweezers
- Little bag for trash
- Ott Light (optional)

## Before Class

Wash and iron all fabrics

Cut a 15" square from your background fabric Please cut, do not tear.
